What are the average annual wages and potential lifetime earnings for professionals working in the HHP K-12 Teaching field?

Occupation	Annual Mean Wage in MT*	Potential Lifetime Earnings*
High School PE Teacher	\$30,200 - \$54,630	\$61,820 x 39 yrs = \$2,410,980
Middle School PE Teacher	\$32,640 - \$54,220	\$61,320 x 39 yrs = \$2,391,480
Elementary School PE Teacher	\$53,110 - \$59,270	\$61,400 x 39 yrs = \$2,394,600
Coach / Scout	\$35,400 - \$43,420	\$37,970 x 39 yrs = \$1,480,830

The Teacher Licensure Option prepares students to teach Health Enhancement (physical education and health education) in grades K-12. The program provides complete and progressive preparation combining a liberal arts education, professional teacher preparation, and specialty knowledge in health and physical movement. Wide ranging experiences in the classroom allow pre-service students to learn and develop their teaching skills.
