in the Enjoy section of the Billings Gazette and have designed posters and tickets for the show.

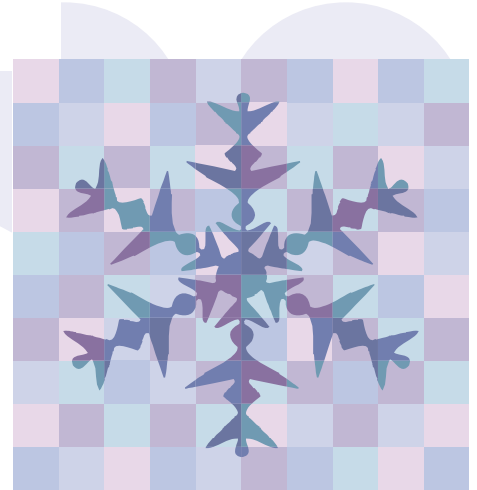
