- To challenge the accuracy or completeness of your FBI criminal history record, you should send your challenge to the agency that contributed the questioned information to the FBI. Alternatively, you may send your challenge directly to the FBI at:

 https://www.wvoems.org/media/355447/fbi%20challenge%20of%20record%20brochure.pdf. The FBI will then forward your challenge to the agency that contributed the questioned information and request the agency to verify or correct the challenged entry.

 Upon receipt of an official communication from that agency, the FBI will make any necessary changes/corrections to your record in accordance with the information supplied by that agency.

- Candidates have 45 days to provide the results of any challenged record(s).

- Course registration for any course requiring the background report is based on the background report received, this includes student teaching or school counseling internship applications, regardless of record challenge status.
