Polling Methods

• The Montana State University Billings Student Engagement Poll was conducted from November 19, 2019 to November 27, 2019, through an anonymous link.

• Face-to-face requests, social media posts, and a QR code, posted in the MSUB library and LA building, distributed the link to the survey.

This report contains the results of a sample of 109 respondents.

- How often do you look for information concerning events, or other activities related to MSU Billings? (This includes sporting events, VIP visits or lectures, club meetings, etc.)




- If they answer never: Skips next two questions.

- Do you want Montana State University Billings to work on how it delivers important information about campus events to students and/or the community?




- If they answer no: Skips to the End of the Survey.
- How would you like MSU Billings to deliver important information about campus events? (Please select up to 3)


What are your primary sources of information concerning events or other activities at MSU Billings? **Community and Family Members**, sorted by <u>former/future student status</u>:




What are your primary sources of information re: MSU-Billings? (Students)




How would you like MSU-Billings to deliver important information? (Community/Family)




Faculty or Staff: How would you like MSU Billings to deliver important info? (Note: Alumni do not want Retort)




Only <u>Traditional Students</u>: How would you like MSU-B to deliver info, sorted by interest:




Only **Non-Traditional Students**: How would you like MSU-B to deliver info, sorted by interest:
