Course Description

Provides students an individual opportunity to engage in education and training not covered by regular coursework. Students will be working directly for a brewery, distillery, or winery. Students, through advising with course instructor, must select either the 45 hour professional internship or professional project option (business, scientific, brew house/mechanical, etc.) in consultation with the site supervisor for their capstone experience.

*Each student must choose one of two options and complet the coursesponding contract (attached).

Option One (Internship)

Students choosing option one will make arrangements with a brewery or distillery or winery in the area to complete an internship. Students must document 45 work hourse to complete the internship. With the internship, students are expected to work and train closely with a site supervisor who agrees to supervise the internshp. This is arrangement is to be completed in consultation with course instructor. This option is intended to be mainly focused on student who wish to seek work as a brewer or vintner or distiller. Students must complete the attached internship contract to designate their choice, internship site, and duties.

Option Two (Project)

Students choosing option two will make arrangements with a brewery or distillery or winer in the area to determine a real-world project the student may complete on behalf of the project site supervisor. The amount of work is intended to be equal to 1 credit our of academic course work. Students must make arrangements with a project site supervisor in concultation with course instructor as to the nature of the project. Projects may included, but not limited to, business plans, marketing plans, growth/expansion plans, personnel, distribution, or anything broadly associated with commercial breweries, distillaries, and wineries.

Course Policies

1. Remember you represent MSUB with your presence at internship/project sites. We expect you to behave with professional decorum and ethics.
2. Your grade depends on the recommendation of the site supervisor so MSUB expects you to provide the best service possible to your internship/project site. Any questions see rule 1 for further guidance.
3. As an extension to rule 1, be sure to treat other MSUB students you may encounter with respect and curtesy if/when you encounter them at the internship site.
