

Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Scholarship Application



For a full-time student, the value of the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Scholarship is approximately \$33,000 towards a bachelor's degree (over \$8200 per academic year), or \$5000 for two academic years (\$2500 per academic year) at the College of Technology. To be eligible for the Western Undergraduate Exchange Scholarship, you must apply for admission to MSU Billings or MSU Billings College of Technology and meet the requirements listed on the back of this application.

Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Scholarship

The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Scholarship, a program coordinated by the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE), rewards a student's academic achievement by offering a reduced tuition level: in-state tuition plus fifty percent of that amount. All bachelors' degrees are eligible for WUE, subject to enrollment limits established by the Montana Board of Regents.

- The recipient must be a resident from one of the following states:

Alaska	Idaho	South Dakota
Arizona	Nevada	Utah
California	New Mexico	Washington
Colorado	North Dakota	Wyoming
Hawaii	Oregon	

- The recipient must meet the non-Montana resident admissions standards.
- The recipient may not use the time spent as a WUE student to meet the 12 month residency requirement to earn Montana residency status.
- The recipient must be working toward the completion of his/her **first undergraduate degree**.
- The recipient must reapply for the WUE Scholarship if he/she does not attend one full semester and returns to MSU-Billings.
