### **Incoming Freshmen, New Transfer, and New Graduate Student Scholarship Application**

Incoming freshmen and new transfer students must apply for admission before completing the Scholarship Application. The **Scholarship Application** is available online at [www.msubillings.edu/scholarships](http://www.msubillings.edu/scholarships). Incoming freshmen and new transfer scholarships will be awarded on an on-going basis beginning December 1. Priority will be given to those who apply before **February 1**. For new graduate students, priority will be given to those who apply before **February 1**.

### **Chancellor's Excellence Awards**

The **Chancellor's Excellence Awards** will be awarded each year to freshmen entering Montana State University Billings in September. Recipients receive \$3,000 per academic year. Scholars who meet or exceed all of the renewal criteria may expect to have their awards renewed for four years for a maximum award of \$12,000. To apply for the Chancellor's Excellence Awards, submit the scholarship application by **January 15**. ## **SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE**

The scholarships listed in this publication have been awarded in previous years or are new scholarships. A few awards may vary for the 2012-2013 academic year in the selection criteria, amount, and/or availability. The listing is categorized as follows: General Scholarships, Scholarships for College of Allied Health Professions majors, scholarships for College of Arts & Sciences majors, scholarships for College of Business majors, scholarships for College of Education majors, scholarships for College of Technology majors, and scholarships for Student Athletes.

## **General Scholarships:**

### **Abrahamson Family Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: 4 @ \$2,500. Definite financial need; must have and maintain at least a 2.75 cumulative GPA or above; full-time enrolled student; Montana or Wyoming resident; preference given to non-traditional students.

### **Hubert & Viola Abrams Endowed Scholarship in Memory of Dora & Charles Hout**

\* Award: \$700. Junior or senior; definite financial need; full-time enrolled student; 3.0 GPA or above; resident of eastern Montana.

### **Jean Albus & Richard Gessling Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$400. Preference given to non-traditional students with a disability that meets the Americans with Disability Act or to students who are single parents; available to students who are residents of or have graduated from a high school in the following counties: Big Horn, Carbon, Rosebud, Stillwater, Sweet Grass, or Yellowstone; definite financial need; 2.0 GPA or above, with preference given to students who are not normally entitled to scholarships based on achievement; recipients must be enrolled for a minimum of 6 credits per semester while receiving scholarship.

### **ASMSUB Future Leaders Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$500 regular scholarship to COT student; \$350 book scholarship to main campus student. Scholarships available to one full-time student on the main campus and one full-time student at the COT. Currently enrolled students must be involved on campus and have potential for campus leadership; incoming freshman must have been involved in high school and have potential for campus involvement and leadership. Recipients must have financial need and 2.0 GPA or above. Student government members (senators, staff and E.C.) are not eligible for scholarship. Recipients must participate in at least one campus clean-up and provide a letter at year-end describing their involvement on campus, how the scholarship affected them, and also their future plans for leadership and campus involvement.

### **Bieber Endowed Scholarship for Students with Disabilities**

\* Award: \$1,800. Adults (18 and older) with a disability that meets the definition of the Americans with Disability Act; must have and maintain at least a 2.0 GPA or above.

### **Chet Blaylock Memorial Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$590. Full-time student enrolled for a minimum of 15 credits per semester; graduate of a Montana high school; Montana resident; high school GPA of 3.5 or above, university GPA of 3.25 or above; two letters of recommendation; student who shows "promise in chosen field".

### **CynDee Bowers Memorial Scholarship**

\* Award: \$500. Scholarship available to students who are members of Student Opportunity Services. Single parent; 2.75 cumulative GPA or above; enrolled for a minimum of 9 credits per semester.

### **Briggs Distributing Co., Inc./John & Claudia Decker Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: Up to \$5,400. Sophomore, junior, senior, or graduate student; 3.0 cumulative GPA or above; traditional student preferred; financial need; full-time enrolled student. Preference given to children of employees of Briggs Distributing Co., Inc. Class status will be waived if applicant(s) are children of employees.

### **Jimmy R. Bromgard Scholarship Fund**

\* Award: Varies. Fund will provide money for tuition, fees, and books for any person who was wrongly convicted of a crime in Montana and set free and who wishes to attend MSU Billings.

### **Carbon County Recognition Scholarship**

\* Award: 2 @ \$500. One scholarship available to traditional student and one scholarship available to non-traditional student; Carbon county resident; Montana resident; financial need; full-time enrolled student with a minimum of 12 credits per semester; available to freshmen through seniors in college; traditional students must have a 3.0 high school GPA and must maintain a 3.0 college GPA while receiving scholarship; non-traditional student must have a high school diploma or GED and must maintain a 2.5 college GPA while receiving scholarship; traditional student must have letter of recommendation from high school counselor or high school teacher; non-traditional student must have letter of recommendation from community member.

### **Career Services Student Advocate Outstanding Service Award**

\* Award: \$250/semester; \$500/year. Available to freshmen through seniors in college; must be an active member of Career Services Student Advocates; must attend  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the monthly meetings and complete five office hours per semester; must actively participate in career events such as: info tables, class presentations, Ask an Executive, Grad Phoning, Tech Expo, Career Fitness Fair, & TRI; must have and maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA; interested student must include with their scholarship application, 3 letters of recommendation and an *essay on how they have benefited from being involved in Student Advocates.*

### **Bruce H. Carpenter Non-Traditional Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: Up to \$3,000. Non-traditional student; Montana resident; freshman in college; financial need; full-time student enrolled for a minimum of 15 credits per semester; three letters of recommendation (at least one from a community member and one from a faculty/advisor); *students interested in applying for the scholarship must attach to their scholarship application an essay describing their educational goals and objectives which includes a description of why they believe campus/community involvement is an important part of their growth and development and a brief description of the contributions they would like to make to the campus and community during the time of their undergraduate education.* First time enrolled freshmen must have at least a 22 composite ACT score (or 1530 SAT score) and have a 3.5 GPA **OR** have an endorsement from a counselor or advisor. Currently enrolled freshmen must have completed 15 semester hours or less of coursework at the post-secondary level and have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or better.

### **Robert J. & Joan M. Carr Access Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$550. Student with definite financial need; 2.5 GPA or above; full-time student.

### **Chancellor's Excellence Awards**

\* Award: \$3,000/year for four years. **Interested students MUST complete the Chancellor's Excellence Awards application** available online at <http://www.msubillings.edu/finaid/Scholarship-ChancellorExcellence.htm>. **DEADLINE to submit application is JANUARY 15.** Traditional or non-traditional entering freshmen; enrolled full-time for a minimum of 15 credits per semester; 26 ACT or 1760 SAT; rank in top 10% of high school graduating class **OR** have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or better; (applicants who are home school, charter high school, or G.E.D. graduates, or applicants who have been out of high school more than three years, must satisfy the ACT or SAT requirements listed above); evidence of leadership and a record of school/community service; three letters of recommendation. Applicants must sign a declaration of intent to complete a four-year undergraduate degree conferred by MSU Billings and be enrolled in an MSU Billings bachelors' degree program. ### **Cobb Foundation Scholarship**

\* Award: Varies. Junior or senior in college; 3.0 cumulative GPA or above; Montana resident, full-time enrolled student; financial need.

### **Collegiate License Plate Endowed Scholarships**

\* Award: 18 @ \$500 or 9 @ \$1,000. Recipients must have successfully completed a minimum of 30 semester credit hours at MSU Billings; Montana resident; 2.5 GPA or above; preference given to full-time students; graduate students are eligible.

### **Creative Writing Endowed Scholarship in Memory of Ben Gloege**

\* Award: \$275. Recipients must have upper division status; candidates should have taken at least two (2) creative writing courses at MSU Billings; judgments will be made in relation to quality of portion of a portfolio of student's creative writing work submitted by student. *Interested students must submit a portfolio of their work to the Department of English, Philosophy & Modern Languages by March 1<sup>st</sup>. For further information contact the Department of English, Philosophy & Modern Languages.*

### **Dickerson/Knight Access to Education Endowed Scholarship for Non-Traditional Women**

\* Award: \$3,500 per year for up to four academic years. Female; non-traditional student as defined by the Financial Aid Office; freshman in college; full-time enrolled undergraduate student; financial need; three letters of recommendation must accompany scholarship application. First time freshman must have a high school GPA of 2.5 **OR** have an endorsement from a counselor or advisor. Freshman with coursework at the post-secondary level may also be considered; student with college credits must have at least a 3.25 cumulative GPA. Finalists must agree to be interviewed by the MSU Billings Foundation's Scholarship Committee.

### **Betty Dunn Memorial Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$650. Female student; financial need; full-time student; single parent.

### **Jorgen Egeland Memorial Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$1,000. Available to students who are graduates of high schools from rural Montana communities with preference given to students who are graduates from high schools in Sheridan and Daniels Counties; sophomore or junior in college; 3.0 cumulative grade point average or above; financial need; full-time student enrolled for a minimum of 12 credits per semester.

### **Lester & Cora Engdahl Memorial Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$1,000. Preference given to graduates of Garfield County High School; scholarship available to incoming freshmen through seniors in college or graduate students enrolled in an undergraduate, graduate or vocational degree program; recipients must have and maintain at least a 2.5 GPA; preference will be given to students in need of financial assistance; traditional recipients must be enrolled full-time with a minimum of 12 credits per semester; non-traditional students may be part-time with a minimum of 6 credits per semester; recipients should demonstrate the drive and ability to enroll and graduate in their chosen field; preference will be given to incoming freshmen. If no incoming freshmen meet the above criteria, the scholarship may be awarded to a previous recipient or upperclassman who meets the criteria.

### **Facilities Services Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$870. Recipient must be a full-time employee of MSU Billings Facilities Services or an immediate family member of a full-time employee or retired employee of Facilities Services.

### **Edna Frost Bookstore Scholarship**

\* Award: Two awards, covering up to \$5,470 for tuition and fees for the academic year. One male and one female recipient; 3.0 GPA or above; financial need; Montana resident; must have completed two semesters as a full-time student at MSU Billings; must be enrolled as a full-time student.

### **Garfield Community Resource Center Scholarship**

\* Award: \$500. Available to residents of south Billings or students at Garfield Community Resource Center; must have financial need; must be attending MSU Billings or MSU Billings COT, but do not have to be working toward a specific degree program; full- or part-time student. *The essay portion of the*

*applicant's scholarship application must provide a brief statement explaining applicant's financial need and future plans.*

### **George H. Gloege Endowed Scholarship for Students Actively Interested in Protecting the Environment**

\* Award: \$465. Applicants must be actively advocating for the environment; must have taken at least one course having connection to the environment (said connection to be justified by brief statement); preference given to students completing an upper division course; 2.5 GPA. *Applicant must include a brief statement with their scholarship application, not to exceed one page, establishing their on-going commitment to environmental protection.*

### **Graduate Studies Student Endowed Scholarships**

\* Award: 3 awards @ \$1,000. The awards will honor Drs. McRae, Waterman, and Wilson. See the Office of Graduate Studies regarding application, criteria and deadline date.

### **John F. and Winifred M. Griffith Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: 3 awards, each covering up to \$6,400 for tuition, fees & instructional supplies for the academic year. Full-time enrolled student; sophomore, junior, senior, or graduate student; 3.0 cumulative GPA with at least a 3.25 GPA in major field of study; recipient must demonstrate academic and leadership potential; students enrolled in the College of Technology or who are majoring in theatre are not eligible for scholarship; students must not be on academic or disciplinary probation. *Students receiving the scholarship are eligible to continue to receive the scholarship by annually reapplying. Renewal recipients will receive preference as long as the student shows progress towards their degree and improves their GPA in their chosen discipline.*

### **Walter B. & Barbara J. Gulick Family Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$500. Scholarship funding for an upper division Honors Program student involved in an upper division research project (typically a year-long project). *Contact the Director of the Honors Program at 406-657-2908 for application and selection process.*

### **David & Barbara Hawkins Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$275. Employee, spouse, or child of employee of Treasure State Electric, Premier Realty, Inc., or LAIS Development; 2.0 GPA or above; full- or part-time student.

### **The Haynes Foundation Scholarships**

\* Award: 30 @ \$2,000. Undergraduate student; graduate of an accredited Montana high school; Montana resident; full-time student enrolled for a minimum of 15 credits per semester; 3.5 GPA; financial need. Incoming freshmen must also have a 23 ACT or 1590 SAT scores and must be enrolled in a 4-year degree program. Based on scholarship funding, past recipients will be given first consideration for scholarship awards. Scholarships are not available to music or music education majors or student athletes participating in men's basketball, women's basketball, or women's volleyball, or to a student who receives a full tuition waiver as a result of their participation in an intercollegiate sport.

### **Hearst Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$360. Recipient must be of Hispanic decent; full- or part-time student with preference given to full-time; 2.5 GPA or above; evidence of community or extracurricular involvement; available to freshmen through seniors in college.

### **Heisey Foundation Scholarships**

\* Award: Varies. Scholarships awarded to students who have graduated from specific high schools in north central Montana to include: Augusta, Belt, Browning, C.M. Russell, Cascade, Centerville/Sand Coulee, Central Catholic, Choteau, Conrad, Cut Bank, Dutton/Brady, Fairfield, Fort Benton, Geraldine, Great

Falls High, Highwood, Lincoln High, Montana School for the Deaf and Blind, Paris Gibson Education Center, Power, Shelby, Simms/Sun River, Sunburst/North Toole County, and Valier High Schools; sophomore, junior, or senior in college; selection based on those who will receive the most benefit from the scholarship.

### **Homesteader's Scholarship**

\* Award: 4 @ \$2,000 and 2 @ \$1,000. \$2,000 recipients must be graduates of a high school in Petroleum County; traditional or non-traditional students; freshmen through seniors in college; high school GPA of 2.0 or university GPA of 2.5; full-time student; definite financial need. \$1,000 recipients must be graduates of a high school in Garfield County; traditional or non-traditional students; freshmen through seniors in college; high school GPA of 2.0 or university GPA of 2.5; full-time student; definite financial need.

### **Information Technology Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$380. Available to current employees of the MSU Billings Information Technology Department who are .75 to full-time employees and their spouses or dependent children; freshmen through seniors in college; 3.0 cumulative GPA. *Interested students must also submit a one page Resume and one page essay on "How you plan to use technology in your intended profession".*

### **"Hardy" Kindler Memorial Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: 3 @ \$950. Eastern Montana or Northern Wyoming resident; male; sophomore or above; full-time student; 3.0 GPA; financial need.

### **Curt Kochner Endowed Scholarship for Student Leaders**

\* Award: \$900. Sophomore or above in college; 2.5 GPA or above; full-time student; recipient must have demonstrated significant student leadership in campus involvement (i.e. Student Senate, Residence Halls, Community Involvement, etc.).

### **Brynn & Kara McDonald Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$1,200. Available to incoming freshmen who might not otherwise be able to attend MSU Billings due to financial hardship. Students must demonstrate potential to be successful in college; must have at least a 2.5 high school GPA OR have at least a 22 composite ACT score or 1530 SAT score.

### **McMullen Golden Years Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$980. Incoming freshman; Montana resident; 3.5 GPA; financial need; full-time student.

### **Metz Family Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$525. Non-traditional student; must have financial need; 2.5 cumulative GPA or above; full- or part-time enrolled student.

### **Montana Center on Disabilities Undergraduate and Graduate Scholarships**

\* Award: 8 undergraduate @ \$1,000; 2 graduate @ \$1,000. Student with a disability that meets the definition of the Americans with Disability Act and is registered with MSU Billings Disability Support Services; Montana resident; 2.5 undergraduate GPA or 3.25 graduate GPA; must have unmet financial need; available to full- or part-time enrolled students.

### **Morningstar Non-Traditional Endowed Scholarships**

\* Award: 4 @ \$500. Madison and/or Ruby Valley residents given preference; must be a graduate of a Montana high school; Montana resident; 2.5 GPA or above; financial need; full- or part-time student; non-traditional student; student enrolled in undergraduate, graduate, or vocational degree program.

### **Morningstar Traditional Endowed Scholarships**

\* Award: 3 @ \$1,000. Graduates of high schools in Madison County (includes Sheridan, Twin Bridges,

Ennis, & Harrison) given preference; graduate of a Montana high School; Montana resident; incoming freshman in college; 3.0 GPA or above; full-time student; student enrolled in undergraduate, graduate, or vocational degree program.

### **MSU Billings Alumni Association Scholarship**

\* Award: \$1,000/year for 4-years to main campus recipient; \$1,000/year for 2-years to COT recipient. Recipient must be related to an alumnus of MSU Billings (EMC); incoming freshman in college; graduate of an accredited high school; full-time student; financial need; evidence of leadership, community service, and scholarship ability; written statement of personal/educational goals and objectives; minimum of three letters of recommendation; main campus recipient must be working toward a B.A./B.S. degree program; COT recipient must be enrolled in an A.A./A.A.S. program of study. First time enrolled freshman on the main MSUB campus must have one of the following: 3.5 cumulative GPA, rank in top 10% of high school graduating class, **OR** have an ACT score of 26 or better/SAT score of 1760 or better. Continuing freshman must have a 3.5 GPA or above and must have earned 15 semester credits or less to apply. First time enrolled freshman at the COT must have one of the following: 3.0 cumulative GPA **OR** have an ACT score of 22 or better/SAT score of 1030 or better. Continuing freshman must have a 3.0 GPA or above and must have earned 15 semester credits or less to apply.

### **MSU Billings Foundation Memorial Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$1,175. Incoming freshman; preference given to full-time students; 2.5 GPA or above.

### **MSU Billings Retiree Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$500. Undergraduate student; financial need; 3.25 cumulative GPA or above; enrolled for at least 9 credits per semester; preference will be given to children, grandchildren, or legal ward of retired employees of MSU Billings (or predecessor entity, including COT) or the MSU Billings Foundation.

### **MSU Billings University Women Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$500. Relative of a MSU Billings faculty member. If no relative of a MSU Billings faculty applies for scholarships, then employees of MSU Billings and employees of MSU Billings Foundation who are at least .50 FTE as defined by the employer and taking at least six credit hours per semester may be considered. (Relative is defined as spouse, children, niece, nephew, and grandchildren.)

### **New Montanan Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$400. Available to non-resident students; must have at least a 2.5 GPA; available to freshmen through seniors in college.

### **Nicholson Single Parent Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$1,000. Single parent; must have and maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA.

### **Annetta Nielsen/Grace Leuthold – Chapter E, P.E.O. Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$520. Female student; junior or senior in college; 3.0 cumulative GPA or above; full-time enrolled student.

### **Krystal & Franklin H. Noble Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$1,000. Montana resident; incoming freshman; graduate of public high school in the Flathead Valley area including Flathead Valley, Glacier, Big Fork, Columbia Falls, and Whitefish; minimum high school cumulative GPA of 2.75; ACT composite score of 22 or an SAT combined score of 1530; preference will be given to students who demonstrate significant involvement, during high school, in civic engagement, community service activities, leadership activities, and programs of academic excellence. Three letters of recommendation are required – at least one must be from a high school counselor/administrator and one from a high school teacher.

### **Non-Traditional Undergraduate Student Scholarship**

\* Award: \$480. Non-traditional student; 2.5 GPA or above; preference given to students with financial need.

### **PEO Chapter BL Scholarship**

\* Award: minimum of \$500 per recipient. Female; must have completed sophomore year in college or be a graduate student returning to college (if the applicant is applying for a program of less than four years, the applicant must be returning to school after a break in her education); 2.5 GPA or above; resident of Yellowstone County (exceptions to location may be made at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee); financial need; must have specific goals for employment following the completion of the course of study. Exceptions may be made for post-baccalaureate study. Applicants must be willing to be interviewed by the scholarship Committee or their representatives. *Interested students must complete the PEO Chapter BL Scholarship application. Contact the MSU Billings Foundation Office at 406-657-1624 for the scholarship application. Deadline to apply is April 1, 2012.*

### **Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship**

\* Award: \$1,000. Transfer student from Miles Community College; 3.25 cumulative GPA or above; full-time enrolled student; one letter of recommendation must be from Phi Theta Kappa advisor.

### **Jean King Rahn Memorial, P.E.O. Chapter E Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$640. Female student; junior or senior in college; 3.5 GPA or above; financial need; full-time student.

### **Recognition Endowed Scholarships**

\* Award: Number of awards varies, ranging in value from \$100 to \$1,000. Scholarships awarded to any student enrolled at MSU Billings who exhibits the potential and dedication to succeed; available to freshmen through seniors.

### **Red Lodge Lions Club Scholarship**

\* Award: \$500. Non-traditional student; resident of Carbon County; additional criteria to be determined by Red Lodge Lions Club.

### **Rocky Mountain Bank Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: Up to \$1,850. Financial need; 3.0 GPA or above; preference given to employees, or the spouses or children of employees, of Rocky Mountain Bank who also meet the first two criteria and to applicants from Rocky Mountain Bank's local markets who meet first two criteria. Local markets include: Kalispell, Bigfork, Plains, Stevensville, Whitehall, Bozeman, Plentywood, Broadus, and Billings.

### **Mike Ross Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$2,400. Sophomore or above in college; 3.0 cumulative GPA or above; financial need; preference given to the employees and family members of employees of HDA Management L.L.C.

### **Ronald P. Sexton Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$1,000. Available to freshmen or above in college; financial need; 2.5 GPA or above; available to full- or part-time students; must be working toward a B.A./B.S. or A.A./A.A.S. degree program.

### **Ellen Shields Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$6,000 per year for four years. Incoming freshman; available to students with economic need who are not normally entitled to scholarships provided by the larger companies based on achievement; 2.5 cumulative GPA; full-time enrolled; must be enrolled in a four-year degree program.

### **Debra Dee Siegle Memorial Endowed Scholarship**

\* Award: \$375. Available to students who are coming out of foster care. Preference will be given to incoming freshmen in college; must have financial need; full-time enrolled student.

### **Sky Arrow Scholarship Fund**

\* Award: \$5,000. Available to Native American students from the Fort Peck Reservation. Must be enrolled full-time; 2.0 cumulative GPA or above; must have financial need. Students receiving the scholarship may be eligible to continue to receive the scholarship for up to two additional years or until the recipient has completed his/her undergraduate degree program (whichever comes first). To be considered for continued scholarship assistance, students must annually reapply for the scholarship by completing the MSUB scholarship application.

### **Student Opportunities Services Scholarship**
