Apply for Admission

Complete the application or apply on line at www.msubillings.edu and submit the following:

- ACT or SAT scores optional
- Immunization Records
- High School Transcript, GED test scores or HiSET test scores for review
- Advanced Placement scores, if you have taken Advanced Placement tests
- College transcripts, if you have taken college classes while in high school

- MSU Billings Scholarship Application: Priority is given to those that apply by February 1st – but will be awarded on an on-going basis through September
- Chancellor's Excellence Scholarship: February 1 deadline
- Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Scholarship – awarded upon submission of admission application where it is determined that the individual is from a WUE state/territory

MSU Billings FAFSA school code: 002530

Accept your Financial Aid Award: within 30 days of being awarded

- Choose what you want to accept/decline
