Where: 2 days in Marrakech, 2 days in Essaouira, 17 days in Zawiya Ahansal, 3 day trek and camp in the Central High Atlas Mountains

What: (Course: HADM 494) This global learning experience will take participants to Marrakech, Morocco and to villages in the Central High Atlas Mountains. Students will compare and contrast rural healthcare in Morocco with the healthcare system in Montana and participate in community based, healthcare-related service learning projects. Students will learn about the rich culture and traditions of Morocco, complete a three day trek in the Central High Atlas Mountains to villages accessible only by foot, and see first-hand how healthcare delivery is similar to and different from rural-frontier healthcare in the U.S.
