Intramural Indoor Co-ed Soccer Rules

1. Games will be played 5 on 5. A team must have at least 2 and no more than 3 players of one sex on the floor. A team must have 2 players of each sex present to start a game.
2. The game will be played in two - twenty minute halves, with an intermission of 3 minutes. The game clock will run continuously.
3. The game will be played on half of the gym and a player can play the ball off the side wall and curtain. The end walls, the mesh part of the curtain, the carpeted part of the wall and above, are all out of bounds.
4. A coin toss will determine which team will have possession at the start of the game. Possession at the start on the second half will go to the team that did not begin the game with possession.
5. All participants must have adequate footwear and shin protection.
6. There will be no goalkeepers. No defensive player can remain inside the blue basketball key for more than 5 seconds.
7. There will be no heading, sliding, offsides or out of control shots. If a player has 2 out of control shots or slides, he/she will be given a yellow card (warning). Two yellow cards will result in expulsion from the game and that team playing down a player for the remainder of that game.
8. Shots will only count if the shot is taken from the goal side of half court.
9. One player can only score up to 5 goals per game. Goals scored by that player after that will not count.
10. Substitutions will be made on the fly.
11. The game shall be considered over when a team is ahead by 5 or more goals with 2 minutes two (2) minutes or less left to play.
12. ELIGIBILITY-
 - a) Only current MSU Billings & College of Technology Students/Faculty/Staff that have paid the Rec Fee are eligible.
 - b) MSU Bozeman students can play when they pay the Rec Fee.
 - c) Spouses of current Students/Faculty/Staff can play with spouse only if they have paid the family semester pass.
 - d) *Limit of one male or one female former varsity soccer players per team. Eligibility is considered for a four year college or university.*
 - e) *No current MSUB Varsity Soccer players (Fall 2010) are allowed to play.*
