**Item 99** REC 110 Environment/Leave No Trace. Change credits from 1 to 2.

The course includes an overnight field trip, so it is definitely more than 1 credit. The course will be 15 hours in the classroom, meeting 1 hour each week of the semester, and 15 hours for the field experience. The form was altered to include this information.

Rich Pierce, Chair of the Gen Ed/Related Department at City College, stated that AAS programs have certain requirements for writing, and WRIT 180 and 101 do not meet them. WRIT 180 is only 1 credit, so students must make up the credits elsewhere. WRIT 101 does not really meet the goals of a writing course for an AAS. However, WRIT 101 will be accepted as a substitution.
