

How to Map a Network Drive on a Mac running OS X

Click on Go

Click Connect to Server

Type in the IP of the server. i.e. 192.156.215.211

Click Connect

It will ask for your username and password.

NOTE: If your password is more than 8 characters, it won't work!

Your username is your msubillings e-mail or domain username. i.e.
ngunnels

Your password is what you use to get your e-mail

Click Connect

Click Select Volume

Highlight your username (biol101) and click OK

Your share is now on the desktop. Double click to open. Drag to trash to disconnect.

How To Map A Network Drive from a Macintosh Pre OS X

Go to Apple | Chooser

click on AppleShare

Click on Server IP Address

Type in the IP #

Connect

Type in the Username

Type in the password

You will get a list. *Scroll up or down* to whatever your share name is & double click.

You will now get drive icon on your desktop

When you are done, you want to drag the share icon to your trash.

Please be aware that by default a share is pc only unless requested to be pc/mac share.
