This Week's Schedule:

Tuesday, Dec. 16 – at Western Oregon (Monmouth, OR) Saturday, Dec. 20 – vs. St. Martin's (7 p.m., Alterowitz Gym)

This Week's Opponent:

<u>Western Oregon University Wolves</u> – The Wolves were picked to finish second in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference and so far this season they have proved the voters right. WOU is off to a 5-2 start with its only losses of the season coming to Oregon Tech and BYU-Provo.

Robert Day (6-5 Sr., Portland) leads the GNAC in scoring at 22.9 ppg and is second in school history with 1,698 career points. Day is also averaging 5.9 rebounds a game and is second on the team for assists. Sean Kelly (6-5 Sr., Grand Junction, CO) is netting 19.4 ppg.

The key to defeating the Wolves will be containing Day and Kelly. The two are combining for 42.3 of the team's 75.1 points per game—56-percent! The Yellowjackets-Wolves match up should be fun for fans of 3-point shooting. The Jackets are knocking down 11.25 threes a game while the Wolves are connecting on 8.0. Combined, the two squads are averaging twenty 3-point attempts a game.

St. Martin's College Saints – The Saints have already won more games than they did all of last season. A year after going 2-26, SMC has started the 03-04 season at 3-4. Three of the losses were to teams that could be in the NCAA Tournament come March (Hawaii-Hilo, Humboldt St., and Western Oregon).

Brandon Hartley (6-3 Sr., Phoenix) is tied for the GNAC scoring lead at 22.9 ppg. Niko Nunogawa (6-6 So., Federal Way, WA) is averaging 19.4 ppg in the Saints' much improved offense. SMC is scoring 81 points a game under first year coach Keith Cooper, although they are allowing opponents to score 82.4 ppg.

SMC has been idle since December 6 when they lost at Western Oregon. They will play at Rocky Mountain on Dec. 19 before facing the Yellowjackets Saturday night.

Last Week's Results:

MSUB 76, Humboldt State 104

Last Week's Highlights:

According to head coach Craig Carse, the Yellowjackets played fairly well in their 28-point loss to the Lumberjacks, who are ranked No. 2 in the nation this week. He said the Jackets just didn't have the right answers for stopping All-Americans Austin Nichols and Fred Hooks, who combined for 35 points.

MSUB made fifteen 3-pointers against the Lumberjacks, their highest output this year and the highest total by any PacWest team this season. The Jackets were also 23-of-26 from the free throw line.

Five different players scored double figures for the Yellowjackets, led by Alex Galloway's 17. Galloway also had six rebounds in his best outing as a Yellowjacket. Buddy Windy Boy, who has provided quick scoring sparks this season, dropped in 16 points on five 3-pointers. He is averaging 7.5 points and two 3-pointers a game while playing just under 14 minutes a night.

Jerett Skrifvars recorded his second-straight double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds, although the HSU defense held him to almost half of his season scoring average. He currently leads the Yellowjackets in scoring (17.5), rebounding (7.8), and assists (4.75)

Cameron Munoz scored a dozen points on four 3-pointers. He leads the PacWest in 3-pointers per game (4.25), 3-point percentage (54.8), and field goal percentage (61.0).

Trae Fortier scored 13 points to go with five rebounds and four assists. The junior forward is averaging 16.8 points and 6.2 rebounds per game, ranking in the top ten in the PacWest in both categories.

Notes:

Dave Carse moved into a tie for eighth place all-time for assists this week. He has 307 career assists, tying him with Marty Bertolette. Eight more assists will tie him with Ron Osborne for seventh all-time.

Cameron Munoz is now eleventh for 3-pointers made in a career even though he is just four games into his sophomore season. He passed Dan Thompson this week. Munoz is now three behind teammate Dave Carse for career threes as each chases Brent Montague for ninth all-time at 120.

After facing two of the GNAC's top teams on the road, the Yellowjackets will get the same two teams at home at the end of December and beginning of January. Humboldt State comes calling to Alterowitz on December 29 and Western Oregon visits on January 3. Both games should be big time West Region clashes before all three teams start conference play in January. The Yellowjackets' first conference games will be January 6, 8, and 10 in Hawaii.

2003-2004 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (9th year): Carse is in his ninth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year second in NCAA Division II for both scoring (89.3 ppg) and 3-point shooting (10.7 3-pointers per game). In the last eight seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top three in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and four 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Mark Hamilton (1st year): Hamilton joins the Yellowjacket staff after replacing longtime assistant Brent Montague. A Columbus, Montana native, Hamilton played at MSU-Billings from 1994-1998, helping the Yellowjackets win two Pacific West Conference championships and earn three NCAA Tournament berths. He was the captain of the 1998 team that captured the PacWest title. Hamilton played in 110 games as a Yellowjacket, scoring 1,463 points and making 286 three-pointers. He's still No. 7 on MSUB's all-time scoring list and No. 2 for three-pointers made in a career. Hamilton is also in the Yellowjacket career record book for points per game (10th at 17.9), field goals made (6th with 496), and three-point percentage (4th at 42.56).
