This Week's Opponent:

Western New Mexico University – The Mustangs are much improved over years past. They are 6-11 overall and 1-5 in the PacWest Conference. They won their first conference game last week when they defeated Hawaii Pacific 93-83.

After the win over HPU, the Mustangs dropped a pair to BYU-Hawaii. They had the Seasideers on the ropes on Thursday, leading until the final minute of the game. WNMU led by eight with just five minutes to play, but scored only four points in the final five minutes. The Mustangs lost by 24 to the Seasideers on Saturday.

Western N.M. has lived and died by the 3-pointer again this season. The Mustangs rank 48th nationally for 3-pointers per game at 8.0.

Four players are averaging double figures, all of them guards. Newcomer Mike Sells is averaging 16.3 points per game. He sat out last season after transferring from Northern Arizona. Sells has made 40 3-pointers this season and is shooting 51.9 percent from beyond the arc. He also ranks in the top 40 in the nation for free throw percentage at 85.1 percent.

Matt Enriquez, a junior guard who has arguably been the Mustangs' best player over the past two years, is averaging 16.4 points and 4.2 rebounds per game. He has struggled from 3-point range (29.1 percent), but has found other ways to score.

Trey Clarkson, a true freshman from Tucson, is adding 11.6 points a game. He is shooting 41 percent from behind the arc and is second on the team with 37 threes.

Brendon Malone averaged 10.6 points in 12 games, starting 11. However, he hasn't played a game since the team returned from its three games in Hawaii.

Last Week's Highlights:

Montana State-Billings used a second half surge to down Hawaii Pacific 112-89 on Saturday afternoon. Justin Hassell and Cameron Munoz shared the top scoring honors with 27 points. Hassell was 11-of-14 from the field and 4-of-4 from the line. He also dished out five assists and grabbed a team-high seven rebounds in 28 minutes off the bench. Munoz was 5-of-12 from 3-point range and 6-of-7 from the free throw line. His thirteenth point of the game made him the twentieth player in school history to score at least 1,000 career points.

Freshman Lucas Walker added 19 points after pouring in 32 in Thursday's win. He was a perfect 7-of-7 from the free throw line. Buddy Windy Boy finished with 15 points, hitting 3-of-9 from beyond the arc and 4-of-4 from the line. He also had a game-high four steals and a blocked shot.

Jonathan Wiley finished the game with eight points and a career-high eight assists. Carlin Hughes added seven points and three assists.

The Jackets survived 70 second half points by Hawaii Pacific to win 113-108 Thursday night. Buddy Windy Boy scored 20 points with all three of his triples coming between 4:33 and 3:06 of the second half. He was 6-of-8 from the field.

Cameron Munoz came off the bench to score 18 points for the Yellowjackets. He played 27 minutes in his return after missing Tuesday's game against BYU-Hawaii. Carlin Hughes added 17 points and a career-high nine assists. The Sea Warriors chose to put Hughes on the line late in the game to stop the clock and he converted 8-of-11 from the charity stripe.

The Jackets' Jonathan Wiley added nine points before fouling out. Cody Samuelson finished with five points and six rebounds.

BYU-Hawaii held on for a wild 100-99 overtime win over Montana State-Billings Tuesday.

Lucas Walker led the Yellowjackets with 21 points on 10-of-18 shooting. He also grabbed a game-high eight rebounds. Buddy Windy Boy finished with 20 points, making 4-of-13 from 3-point range. The Yellowjackets were 11-of-34 from behind the arc.

All five starters scored in double figures for MSU-Billings. Justin Hassell added 16 points, connecting on all eight of his free throw attempts. Jonathan Wiley finished with 12 points and three assists, and Carlin Hughes had 11 points. Hughes was 3-of-9 from long range.

2004-2005 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (10th year): Carse is in his tenth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year fourth in NCAA Division II for scoring (93.1 ppg) and first for 3-point shooting (12.4 3-pointers per game). In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (1st year): After playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets, Dave Carse enters his first season as the Special Marketing Director for Men's and Women's Basketball. He is responsible for youth camps, season ticket sales, assisting with corporate partnerships, and game promotions. He is also assisting with the men's team.

Brent Montague (8th year): After a one-year absence, Montague returns to the Yellowjackets for his eighth season. He was Carse's top assistant for seven years from 1996 to 2003. The team captain of Carse's first MSU-Billings team in 1995-96, Montague has been involved with the Yellowjackets since his first year as a player in 1994.
