This Week's Opponent:

Chaminade University – The Yellowjackets open the PacWest Conference schedule against the Silverswords, who are 7-4 overall and 1-0 in the PacWest. Three of the Swords' losses were to big time Division I teams at the Maui Classic.

Chaminade is a balanced team with eight players averaging at least seven points a game. Chris Reaves leads the team in scoring at 14.0 ppg. He is 25-of-59 from behind the arc. Dylan McCune is tops on the team with 31 3-pointers while shooting 39 percent from behind the arc.

Zack Whiting may be one of the best players in the league. He is averaging 12.2 points, 5.7 rebounds and 7.3 assists per game.

University of Hawaii-Hilo – The Vulcans were 12-1 during their early non-conference schedule. Their only loss came at Chaminade on December 4. Since then, UHH has won eight straight.

Three players average double figures for the Vulcans, led by Skip Esene's 19.8 scoring average. He is shooting 54 percent from the field and adding 5.5 rebounds a game. Esene has already been named the PacWest's player of the week twice.

Alex Cabagnet is averaging 11.3 points and leads the team at 5.4 assists per game. Brian Graham is adding 10.2 points a night. The Vulcans have two of the top four shot blocker in the conference. Alex Graham has already blocked 20 shots, and Terrance Troupe has added 15.

UHH is outscoring its opponents by an average of 11.9 points. The Vulcans' +9.4 rebounding margin has played a big role.

Last Week's Results:

MSU-Billings 103, Haskell Indian Nations 81

Last Week's Highlights:

Buddy Windy Boy dropped in eight 3-pointers to lead MSU-Billings to a 103-81 New Year's Eve win over Haskell Indian Nations University. He scored a game-high 29 points as the Yellowjackets improved to 8-1.

After a slow start, the Yellowjackets raced from an 8-7 lead to a double digit advantage in the span of two minutes. Windy Boy made back-to-back 3-pointers during that stretch. MSU-Billings built a 54-40 halftime lead after leading by as much as 22.

The Yellowjackets took control of the game in the second five minutes of the second half. Back-to-back 3-pointers from Windy Boy and Jay Jamieson with just less than 10 minutes to play gave MSU-Billings a double digit lead that it would not relinquish. Senior Justin Hassell was 5-of-6 from the free throw line in the final three minutes to seal the win.

Windy Boy was 8-of-15 from behind the arc and now leads the Yellowjackets with 42 made 3-pointers this season. He also dished out four assists with just one turnover while playing all 40 minutes.

Hassell was one of two Yellowjackets to post a double-double. He finished with 26 points and matched his career high with 12 rebounds. He was 16-of-18 from the free throw line. Jonathan Wiley added 11 points and a career-high 14 rebounds.

Lucas Walker added 22 points and eight rebounds. He was 8-of-14 from the field. Jamieson scored an important six points, hitting 2-of-2 from long range. Carlin Hughes handed out a career-high eight assists.

"We've played our nine preseason games, and now we'll add it up and see what it does to take us into conference play," said Yellowjacket head coach Craig Carse. "We'll be taking a young team on our first conference road trip. We'll see what this experience does for us. I was proud of how the kids played with poise in the second half tonight. Jonathan came down with 14 key rebounds. Justin was solid at the line. And what can you say about Buddy? He played great."

2004-2005 Yellowjacket Coaches

Craig Carse (10th year): Carse is in his tenth season on the Yellowjacket bench and has firmly established MSU-Billings as one of the top offensive teams in the nation. Last year the Yellowjackets finished the year fourth in NCAA Division II for scoring (93.1 ppg) and first for 3-point shooting (12.4 3-pointers per game). In the last nine seasons, MSU-Billings has been ranked in at least the top four in each category, including seven NCAA Division II scoring titles and five 3-point shooting titles. Over Carse's tenure at MSUB, the Yellowjackets have averaged 96.5 points and 11.7 3-pointers per game and have qualified for four NCAA Tournaments. Before arriving at MSU-Billings, Carse was an assistant under Dale Brown at Louisiana State University. Before going to LSU, Carse guided West Virginia State to the NAIA National Championship game in 1984, giving him appearances in national tournaments at the Division I, Division II and NAIA levels.

Dave Carse (1st year): After playing four seasons for the Yellowjackets, Dave Carse enters his first season as the Special Marketing Director for Men's and Women's Basketball. He is responsible for youth camps, season ticket sales, assisting with corporate partnerships, and game promotions. He is also assisting with the men's team.

Brent Montague (8th year): After a one-year absence, Montague returns to the Yellowjackets for his eighth season. He was Carse's top assistant for seven years from 1996 to 2003. The team captain of Carse's first MSU-Billings team in 1995-96, Montague has been involved with the Yellowjackets since his first year as a player in 1994.
