This Week's Opponents:

Montana State University-Northern

The Lights will come to Billings on a roll having won their last three games. MSUN is 8-3 overall this season with a 6-2 home record and a 2-1 road mark. Five of their 13 games have been against Canadian teams, which NAIA schools are allowed to count in their overall records. Two of the Lights' three losses have been to Minot State. Northern averages 81.9 points a game although the Lights have only scored over 80 twice. Their 99 points last week against University of Alberta helped their average. Three players average double figures for scoring, led by DeLayne Johnston's 16.4 ppg. The senior forward was a high school teammate of former Lady Yellowjacket Robyn Milne. Chelsi Searle adds 12.1 ppg, and Ashley Trulock averages 11.4 ppg off the bench. Searle leads the team in 3-point shooting, averaging just under two made per game and hitting at a 47.6 percent clip. (Note: This game will be sponsored by Pizza Hut, which will give a free personal pan pizza to everyone in attendance if MSU-Billings makes at least 10 three-pointers.)

Last Meeting: MSUB 79, MSUN 71 (February 23, 2004 at MSUB)

Streaks: MSUB has won the last three meetings dating to 1998. The Jackets' 83-72 win on January 3, 1998 snapped a five-game Lights winning streak. The longest streak in the series history was a 10-game Yellowjacket winning streak in the first 10 games of the series, ranging from 1974 to 1978.

St. Martin's University

The Saints, just two years removed from an appearance in the NCAA Tournament, enter the week at 3-4 overall, but they have played a tough early season schedule. Their losses have come to Grand Canyon, Northwest Missouri State, North Dakota, and Lewis-Clark State. Coach Tim Healey's crew will take on Northwest University on Thursday before hosting the Yellowjackets on Saturday. The Saints are averaging 65 points a game while giving up 69 points a night. They have scored at least 70 in their last two games. Jessi Reome is the only Saints player to average double figures for scoring at 11.0 ppg. Sade Smith adds 9.4 points and 6.1 rebounds a game. Whitney Golob leads the team in rebounding at 7.4 rpg.

The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets opened the week at home against cross-town rival Rocky Mountain College on Tuesday, winning 85-69. MSUB started the game with a 23-4 run and seemed poised to blow the game open. Rocky responded with its own 18-4 run, forcing the Jackets to settle for a 39-32 halftime lead. The Yellowjackets used a 14-3 run early in the second half to put the game out of reach. They led by as many as 26. Michelle Lieber led all scorers with 22 points, hitting 7-of-9 from the field and 8-of-9 from the free throw line. Alira Carpenter netted 19 points, knocking down 4-of-7 from 3-point range. Kayla McPherson added 15 points, hitting 3-of-6 from behind the arc. The Yellowjackets were 12-of-20 in the game from 3-point. Jen Smith and Rachel Hansen each came off the bench to score career highs with 11 and nine points respectively.

The Jackets ended the week with a tough road trip to Missouri where they lost two regional games. On Thursday Northwest Missouri State was nearly unstoppable in a 95-82 win over the Jackets. Six different players scored in double figures for Bearcats. Five players scored in double digits for MSUB, led by Carpenter's 20 points. Lieber had another double-double with 12 points and 13 rebounds. Jetton Meadors scored a career-high 14 points, McPherson finished with 13, and Smith had 10. Carpenter and McPherson combined for seven of the team's 10 three-pointers.

The road didn't get any easier Saturday when the Jackets played at 25th-ranked Missouri Western State. The Griffons used a stingy defense in the 75-56 win. The Jackets shot just 32 percent from the field and 24 percent from behind the arc. Lieber had a season-high 22 points to go with seven rebounds. Meadors added 10 points and three assists.

Tip Ins

Yellowjacket fans shouldn't get too concerned about the team's 2-3 record just yet. Two of the Jackets' losses have been to teams currently ranked in the top 25 in the nation (North Dakota and Missouri Western), and the third loss was on the road to 6-1 Northwest Missouri State. Combined with exhibition games against Montana State and Montana, Coach Kevin Woodin couldn't have scheduled a much tougher early season slate. Look for the stiff competition in November and December to pay dividends once the Heartland Conference season rolls around....Speaking of the Heartland, the Jackets' rough start pales in comparison to the rest of the league. No team in the HLC has a winning record at this point, and the league's teams have a combined 7-29 record. Four of the six teams already have at least five losses. With overall records like that, it's almost already guaranteed that the only team from the Heartland that will make the NCAA Tournament will be the league champion....We're not trying to jinx her, but freshman forward Dani Henderson has yet to miss a free throw this season. She is 12-of-12 from the charity stripe, going 4-of-4 in three different games....Free throw shooting has been a bright spot for the Yellowjackets so far this season. Six different players are shooting at least 70 percent, and the team is shooting 75.3 percent. Along with Henderson, Alira Carpenter is 8-of-11, Jetton Meadors is 7-of-8, Jen Smith is 10-of-14, Michelle Lieber is 20-of-25, and Kayla McPherson is 2-of-2....A few different school record book chases are already beginning to materialize for 2006-2007. Lieber is off to a solid start in trying to become just the third player in school history to average a double-double for her career. She's also trying to become the 18th player in school history to score over 1,000 points. It will likely be near the end of the season before she can reach those marks, but both are possible. Carpenter's 11 made 3-pointers have moved her to No. 14 in the career school record book already. With a good season, she could approach the top 10 in school history after just two seasons....Pizza Hut is sponsoring Wednesday's game against MSU-Northern. Everyone in attendance will receive a buy-one-get-one-free pizza coupon. Also, if the Jackets make at least 10 three-pointers, everyone in attendance will win a free personal pan pizza.)
