The Yellowjackets and Aggies will never develop a rivalry since MSU-Billings is moving to the Great Northwest Athletic Conference next year. It will be unusual for the teams to ever meet again after this season. But that doesn't mean this year's games won't be heated. After all, the Aggies spoiled the Jackets' postseason last year in the Heartland Conference playoffs. In that first round playoff game, fourth-seeded OPSU was getting blown out by top-seeded MSU-Billings, trailing by as many as 15 in the first half. The Aggies seemingly had every shot fall in the second half (although they actually shot 48 percent from the field) and held the Jackets to just 1-of-19 from 3-point range in the final 20 minutes. OPSU rallied from a 10-point halftime deficit to win going away to advance to the conference championship game.

Panhandle State will bring a 2-9 overall record to Billings for their Heartland Conference opener against the Yellowjackets on Saturday. It will be the second-straight year that the Jackets and Aggies have played the first conference game of the season in the Heartland. The league's other teams will kick of the conference schedule after the first of the year.

For their two wins, the Aggies won their season-opener against New Mexico Highlands and snapped a seven-game losing streak on December 9 at St. Gregory's. They have a –9.8 scoring average, but have been outscored by an average of 76-59 in their nine losses. Their only common opponent with the Yellow-jackets so far has been Missouri Southern. The Jackets beat the Lions by nine last week in Hawaii. MSSU downed OPSU 94-57 in November.

Megan Hamilton and Nina Kuleff are each averaging double figures for the Aggies. Hamilton leads the way at 12.5 ppg, and Kuleff adds 10.1 ppg. Kuleff had a double-double of 18 points and 10 rebound in her last trip to Billings. She's averaging a team-best 8.5 rebounds a game this season. Hamilton is a junior transfer from Northwest Missouri State. She leads the Aggies with 29 three-pointers. Sarah Polson has knocked down 22 threes and averages 9.4 ppg.

The Week in Review

What a week it was for the Lady Yellowjackets. While it was winter in Montana, they spent the week in Hawaii. More importantly, they picked up two huge South Central Region wins at the Hoop-N-Surf Classic. The teams they faced entered the week with a combined 15-1 record and had not lost to a team from the Heartland Conference. Only time will tell if it will turn out to be a season-changing trip, but convincing wins against good opponents can propel teams to new heights.

On Tuesday, the Jackets dominated Abilene Christian, which was 4-0 against other Heartland teams this year. MSUB led by as many as 20 in the second half and cruised to the 86-61 win. Alira Carpenter continued to sizzle, scoring 18 points on 7-of-10 shooting from the field and 4-of-5 from 3-point range. Jen Smith came off the bench to match her career high with 15 points.. Kayla McPherson added 13 points off the bench, and Michelle Lieber had 12 points and eight rebounds. The Jackets shot 53 percent from the field and were 10-of-18 from behind the arc.

On Wednesday, MSUB faced unbeaten Missouri Southern State. The Jackets jumped all over the Lions in the first half, leading 42-26 at the break en route to the 78-69 win. McPherson poured in a career-high 21 points off the bench. She was 6-of-9 from the field and 3-of-5 from 3-point. Lieber notched her fourth double-double of the year with 21 points and 12 rebounds. Carpenter added 16 points, hitting 4-of-7 from 3-point range. Point guard Jetton Meadors scored seven points to go with her career-high six assists.

Tip Ins

The Lady Yellowjackets did a fine job of mixing business with pleasure last week. With finals over and numerous family members making the trip to the islands, coach Woodin gave his crew ample time to enjoy their time in Hawaii. But any doubts about the Jackets' focus was put to rest emphatically. They strung together their best two outings of the year to improve to 7-3 overall and 2-2 against South Central Region teamsSophomore guard Kayla McPherson had a huge week offensively and was named the Heartland Conference player of the week. She was also responsible for the most intriguing stat of the week. Against Abilene Christian on Tuesday (12/19/06) she had a blocked shot. What's so odd about that? She has two blocked shots in her career. The other came against Abilene Christian almost a year earlier to the date (12/20/05)....Last week senior forward Michelle Lieber became the 24th player in school history to score over 800 career points. She's done it in a little over two seasons. If she continues to average 15 ppg, she'll become the 18th Lady Yellowjacket to surpass 1,000 career points....Lieber is second on the team in scoring despite seeing heavy defensive pressure. Every time she touches the ball she draws double and triple teams. As a result, she is averaging 5.6 free throw attempts per game. Last year as a junior she averaged 4.7 attempts per game, and as a sophomore she averaged 2.2. Teams might want to find a way to stop her other than sending her to the line, however. Lieber is shooting a career-best 82 percent from the charity stripe....The single season school record for free throw percentage is Jenni Winter's 87.3 percent in 1998-99. Four Yellowjackets are over 80 percent for the season so far with Meadors at 92%, Henderson at 88%, Carpenter at 83%, and Lieber at 82%. All four are on pace to reach the required 50 makes to be eligible for the record book.
