#### This Week's Opponents:

##### Oklahoma Panhandle State University

The Aggies are off to a tough start at 2-12 overall and 0-3 in the Heartland Conference. By the time the Yellowjackets visit Oklahoma on Friday, the Aggies will have gone over a month without a win. But you can bet Coach Woodin and the Jackets aren't taking the two games in Goodwell lightly. OPSU started last season 6-10 before becoming the Cinderella team of the conference down the stretch. The Aggies won nine of their last 13 games, including a first round conference playoff game in Billings.

Megan Hamilton and Sarah Polson average 12 and 10 points respectively. Nina Kuleff adds 9.5 points and 8.4 rebounds a game. She ranks third in the conference for rebounds per game. Defensively, the Aggies are an anomaly. They rank dead last in the league for scoring defense, allowing over 70 points a game. Yet OPSU is the top team in the league for field goal percentage defense, holding teams to just 38 percent shooting from the field.

##### University of Texas-Permian Basin

The Falcons have yet to play at home this season and enter the week at 0-11. They will host Lincoln University on Saturday in their home opener before taking on the Yellowjackets next Monday. The Falcons have taken their lumps through the first 11 games, giving up an average of 86.6 points a game. They have allowed over 100 points twice and over 80 points in six other games.

Calli Smith and Amanda Synatschk each average double figures. Smith is a 5'9" freshman who averages 12.7 points and a team-best 7.3 rebounds a game. She has scored in double figures the last two games. Synatschk, a 5'10" junior adds 10.3 points per game. Amy Synatschk and Michelle Thowsend each average about five rebounds a game.

## The Week in Review

The Yellowjackets won three games last week to extend their current winning streak to nine games. MSUB pulled away from a feisty Texas A&M-International 82-64 on Thursday then hammered St. Edward's twice, 76-57 on Saturday and 78-61 on Sunday.

In Thursday's win, Jen Smith came off the bench to score a career-high 18 points and grab seven rebounds. Michelle Lieber posted a double-double of 18 points and 10 rebounds. Kayla McPherson added 13 points, and Jetton Meadors had 10. Shantell Marquis dished out nine assists and had five steals.

Saturday's game against St. Ed's was the only conference counter of the week, and the Jackets made the most of it to improve to 2-0 in the conference. Alira Carpenter matched her career high with 28 points. She made six 3-pointers, missing the school record by one. Lieber notched her sixth double-double of the season with 13 points and 13 rebounds. McPherson knocked down four 3-pointers for 12 points.

In Sunday's non-conference game against the Hilltoppers, Carpenter led all players with 19 points, hitting 3-of-6 from 3-point range. Lieber and McPherson each netted 14 points. Senior guard Jennifer Skrifvars came off the bench to score a career-high 13 points. She was 3-of-3 from the field, including 2-of-2 from 3-point land and 5-of-9 from the line. Smith added 11 points, and Meadors handed out a career-high seven assists.

## Tip Ins

The Lady Jackets' current nine-game winning streak is tied for the third-longest in school history, tying the 2001-2002 team. With two games this week and another on Monday, the Jackets will have a shot at the second-longest streak in school history. The 1990-1991 team won 11 in a row. The school record winning streak was set at 14 games by last year's team....Last week sophomore guard Alira Carpenter eclipsed her 3-point total of her entire freshman season. Her 47 threes through the first 14 games rank 11th in the single season school record book. She'll climb that list rapidly, needing to reach just 54 to move to 7th. The single season school record for 3-pointers is 75 by Jenni Winter in 1998-1999....Michelle Lieber passed her former teammate Jenny Langford for 21st in the school record book for career points. Lieber's 885 points, 216 of which have come this year, put her in range of becoming the 18th Yellowjacket to score 1,000 career points. Lieber also went over 600 career rebounds last week, moving her to 12th in school history. Eleven of the other 12 players in school history with at least 600 career rebounds also scored over 1,000 points....The Jackets' bumpy 2-3 start to the season seems like a distant memory. Carpenter and Lieber have had a lot to do with that, but as much credit should go to a number of players who have stepped up their play since the beginning of December. Sophomore Kayla McPherson is averaging 10.1 ppg off the bench. Sophomore Jetton Meadors leads the conference in assists and assist/turnover ratio. Freshman Shantell Marquis is in the top five in the conference for assists, steals, and assist/turnover ratio. Sophomore Jen Smith has averaged 9.6 ppg in the last eight games. Freshman Dani Henderson leads the conference in free throw percentage.
