## **Important Upcoming Dates**

It is always a good idea to reference the Academic Calendar for important academic timelines and breaks. Here are just a few:

The last day to drop a class without instructor approval (no refund) is Thursday, March 13, 2025. If you're considering dropping a class, we encourage you to speak with your professor and advisor about options. It is important to keep in mind that dropping a course at this point in the semester is not uncommon, but keeping the Ws to a minimum is the goal. Dropping a course can impact student financial aid so please reach out to the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships as part of your decision-making process.

If you need help learning who your advisor is, you can find that information in <u>myInfo</u> or <u>Navigate</u> or you can reach out directly to <u>Advising</u> for additional information.

## Time to Register for Fall 2025 Classes and Apply to Graduate!

Registration begins on March 17, 2025, for all Graduate, Senior, and City College students. Juniors can register on March 18, Sophomores on March 19, and First-time Spring and Transfer students on March 20. Please see your academic advisor in advance of your registration day to discuss your schedule and obtain your advising registration PIN (if applicable). Schedule an appointment now using the Navigate app or by calling your advisor. Fall classes begin Wednesday, September 3, 2025.

<u>Summer course registration</u> opened February 18, 2025 – consider taking a few classes to stay on track for graduation. Be sure to fill out the <u>summer aid request form</u> if you need summer financial aid.

Planning to <u>GRADUATE</u> this summer or fall? Applications are due to the <u>Registrar's Office</u> March 28, 2025. [If you are planning to finish/graduate in May and have not submitted a graduation application, please call Karen in the Registrar's Office at 406-657-1782 immediately]. Please check your degree progress through <u>DegreeWorks</u> in <u>myInfo</u> and visit with your advisor about graduation requirements.

**Spring Mini-Break and University Day** – while offices are open, classes are not in session Thursday, April 17 and Friday, April 18, 2025, and Friday, April 25, 2025. Use the time wisely to get caught up, get ahead, and plan for a strong finish to spring semester.

**Finals week** is April 28-May 1, 2025. Please make sure to check your course syllabus in each class for finals information. Final Exam dates and times are generally different from your scheduled class times and vary for <u>University campus</u> and <u>City College campus</u> courses.
