1. ARTZ 402 is required in the Professional Core. Students must be enrolled in a state certified teacher licensure program or hold a current teaching license by the time they enroll in ARTZ 402.
2. ARTZ 403 is required in the Professional Core, and it has a corequisite of EDU 354.

Certain courses in this program have prerequisites; others are offered only in alternate years. Students should check the course descriptions in the General Bulletin for required prerequisites.

A grade of “C” or higher is mandatory in all Art classes satisfying minor requirements.

For students gaining teaching licensure in a content major, this minor leads to endorsement. All students desiring licensure to teach are required to file an Application for Admission to the Teacher Education Program.
