XIV. PUBLIC COMMENT

- Brenna- Concern over Voc Rehab midterm changes
 - Students were notified late or not notified at all that books and course materials would not be covered
 - Changes were made midterm and blocked course access undermining students' education and causing financial strain
 - Voucher sent last semester did not work and it was not remedied
 - Students would like clear clarification on why this change is happening and assurance that they will continue to cover tuition. They would also like immediate support for required materials for courses as well as consideration of IEP accommodations for funding
 - VR is requiring students to use comparable benefits for all expenses that are not fees or tuition
 - There was no due process as they did not give any notice to students of this change
- Senator Roberts was informed that they would no longer cover anything but tuition- Brenna noted that students are not supposed to be notified over the phone and that this was supposed to be relayed in person with a moderator present
 - Senator Roberts would like to know how many students who have not returned this semester due to this change and lack of funding
 - Shared that he uses his comparable funding to live throughout the year as a non-traditional student
- President Sneigoski asked for clarification on what Voc Rehab is. Brenna shared her story and Senator Roberts shared his story.
