## Cross Country: Sixty-One Named To GNAC Academic Team

SPOKANE, Wash. - A total of 61 student-athletes – 22 men and 39 women - have been named to the 2008 Great Northwest Athletic Conference cross country all-academic team.

Heading up the women's academic squad is Krinda Carlson of Saint Martin's. The English major from Pateros has a perfect 4.00 grade point average. Justin Karr of Western Oregon has the best GPA among the men with a 3.98 GPA. Karr is a political science major from Tigard.

Eight of the athletes – Cornelius Sigei of Alaska Anchorage; Elisabeth Habermann, Julie (Coulter) Pierson and Anna Coulter, all from Alaska Fairbanks; Marcie Mullen of Central Washington; Ashley Puga and Jennifer Young of Northwest Nazarene, and Katie Hart of Seattle Pacific - were all honored for the third time. Twenty other athletes were repeat selections.

To be eligible for the academic team, student-athletes must have a minimum grade point average of 3.20 and be in at least their second year of competition at their university.
