**MSUB WOMEN'S SOCCER**  
**2008 Game Notes**

**BRIEFLY**

MSUB returns to the road looking to improve on its fourth place standing in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference. The Yellowjackets travel to Western Oregon (Thursday) and Saint Martin's on Saturday. The Jackets defeated both Western Oregon and Saint Martin's earlier this season in Billings. MSUB is 8-7 overall and 3-4 in conference play. With a win this week, the Yellowjackets can equal their win total from a year ago with three games to play.

**SCOUTING MSUB**

The Montana State Billings Yellowjacket women's soccer team enters the week with a 8-7 record and a 3-4 record in conference play. The Yellowjackets snapped a two game conference skid last week with an impressive 4-0 victory over Northwest Nazarene and followed with a heartbreaking 3-2 overtime loss to Rocky Mountain College in the Seventh Annual Rimrock Cup. The Jackets fought valiently to come from behind before losing on a free kick from about 35-yards out.

Leading the way for the Jackets this season is Kari Foreman, who has five goals, two assists and 12 points thus far. She is third on the team with 23 shots and second on the team with 14 on goal and has two games winners. Ali Gamberg is second on the team with 11 points courtesy of four goals and three assists. Gamberg has one game winner and leads the team with 34 shots and 23 on goal. In addition, she has scored three goals in the past three games to lead the team. She had just one score in the first 12 contests. Melissa Carlson and Chelsea Libby each have three goals, while Mandy Ploskonka and Samantha Sandau lead the team with four assists each.

In goal, the Jackets are led by Jordan Fenwick who has played and started in 14 games. She has a 7-7 record with three shut-outs to go along with a 1.79 goals against average and 66 saves. She has allowed 24 goals on the year. Brittany Knudtson earned her first start of the season against Western Oregon and carries a 1-0 record with a 0.54 gaa and seven saves. She has played in a total of four games this season.

**RECAPPING LAST WEEK**

The Yellowjackets got back on the winning track this past week as they split two contests. MSUB pulled within one game of .500 in league play with a convincing 4-0 home victory over Northwest Nazarene and dropped a heartbreaking 3-2 overtime decision to arch-rival Rocky Mountain College in the Seventh Annual Rimrock Cup. Against Rocky, the Yellowjackets were down 1-0 and 2-1 in the second half and rallied to tie the game each time.

**SCOUTING WESTERN OREGON**

The Wolves enter the week with a 5-7-2 record and are 1-2-1 in their past four games, including a 2-1 setback at MSUB Oct. 4. WOU is 1-2-2 in conference play. The Wolves are led by Melinda Ingalls who leads the team with eight goals and two assists for

second on the team in assists with three.

In goal, Ashley Engel leads the way with a 4-9-1 record and a 1.89 goals against average. She has 79 saves with 24 goals against in 13 games.

**INSIDE THE SERIES**

The Yellowjackets own a 2-1 record in the series including a come-from-behind overtime victory in Billings, Oct. 2. The Jackets posted a 3-2 win for its first conference victory of the year. Jill Jensen scored a goal in each half to give SMU a 2-0 lead. With just under seven minutes to go in regulation, the Jackets caught fire and scored two goals to tie and won it in overtime. In 2007, the Jackets won a 6-2 decision in Billings in the first meeting and dropped a 2-0 decision in Lacey later in the season.

**DA ALI G SHOW**

No one on the team has been hotter in the last three games than Ali Gamberg. She has scored three impressive goals in each of the last three games. Gamberg's first goal and second of the season came as the equalizer in a 2-1 loss at Central Washington Oct. 11. The goal came just over two minutes into the second half to tie the game at one. She added another goal, the fourth and final goal, in a 4-0 home victory over Northwest Nazarene Oct. 16 and scored the equalizer again in the 47th minute against Rocky Mountain College this past Saturday to tie the game at one. RMC eventually won the game 3-2 in overtime on a free kick. Through the last three games, she has three goals one assist for seven points to lead the team. She also has 11 shots and nine on goal.

**\*JACKETS LIKE THE CRUSADERS**

The Yellowjackets posted their second-straight 4-0 victory over NNU this past Thursday. Since 2007, the Jackets now have outscored NNU 11-1 in three meetings. The Jackets travel to Nampa Nov. 6.

**TAKE IT TO THE CORNER**

The Yellowjackets have 56 corner kicks this season compared to 41 by the opponents. However, MSUB has a 33-14 lead in corner kicks in the second half and the opponents have a 26-22 advantage in the first half. Last season, the Jackets tallied just 55 corners all season and allowed 87.

**CLUTCH JACKETS**

The Yellowjackets scored two goals in the last seven minutes of regulation and scored a goal in overtime for a dramatic 3-2 victory over Saint Martin's Oct. 2. It was the Yellowjackets' first conference victory of the season. Even more impressive, the Jackets scored the equalizer with just 19 seconds left in regulation and won the game with 23 seconds left in the first overtime.

**VALENTINE'S DAY**

Don Trentham enters his seventh year as head women's soccer coach at MSU Billings in 2008. Under Trentham's direction the

program has gone 53-49-8. He is the most successful coach in the history of the program in terms of both total wins and winning percentage, and his teams have posted the only three winning seasons in team history. In addition to his role as the head women's coach, Trentham is in charge of the fundraising and the development of Yellowjacket Field, which in the spring of 2008 received a facelift with the addition of a state-of-the-art synthetic turf playing field.

Trentham attended Columbia College (Missouri) and played for head coach Dan Hogan, who is now head coach at University of Southern Indiana. At Columbia he was part of an NAIA program that was consistently ranked in the top-20, won two conference tournament championships and twice advanced to the regional tournament. In his senior year, the team finished 17-5 and was ranked ninth in the nation.

Trentham began his collegiate coaching career as an assistant at Embry-Riddle University in Daytona Beach, Florida where he had the chance to work two seasons with one of the finest soccer tacticians in the country – David Gregson. At Embry-Riddle he assisted in guiding the team to a #16 NAIA National Ranking in the final poll of 1999 season, two NAIA Regional Tournament appearances and a Florida Sun Conference regular season championship.

"I've been very fortunate to have played for and coached with two great people," says Trentham. "Much of what I learned about the game came from Coach Hogan and David Gregson. Had it not been for those guys, I don't know if I'd be

coaching today."

Aside from his head coaching duties with the team at MSU Billings, Trentham also plays an active role in developing players throughout the state and the region. Over the past three years he has served as the u13 and u14 girls head coach for the Magic City Soccer Club, guiding three teams to Montana State Youth Soccer Championships. In the past he has also coached in the Olympic Development Program serving as the ODP girl's head coach for Montana, as well as an ODP staff coach for Region IV. Furthermore, he holds many camps, clinics, tournaments, and leagues during the course of the year for both adult and youth players throughout the state.

Trentham earned his Bachelor of Arts in Education from Columbia College and a Master of Education in Sport Management from East Stroudsburg University. He holds an "A" and "National Goalkeeping" licenses from the United States Soccer Federation, as well as an Advanced National license from the National Soccer Coaches Association of America.



The 2008 season will be Stroup's second as the Yellowjackets' women's soccer assistant coach. She is a 2007 cum laude graduate

from MSU Billings, earning a Bachelor of Arts Degree in psychology with a minor in coaching.

"Ally continues to be a valuable asset to the soccer program here at MSUB," said Head Coach Don Trentham. "She has worked very hard the past year in making the transition from player to coach and is settling in nicely in her role as assistant coach. She knows the game very well and has a tremendous passion for MSUB soccer, and it is exciting to watch her pass on that knowledge and passion to the players."

As a player, Stroup was a four year

starter and two-time captain for the Yellowjackets. Her freshmen season she was named to the NSCAA/adidas All-West Region Second Team. As a junior, she received the following honors: MSU Billings Most Valuable Student-Athlete, Heartland all-conference team, scholar-athlete by her teammates, and ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District VII Second Team. For her senior season, she received the following honors: ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District VII second team, Dakrtonics all-Midwest Region, scholar-athlete and MVP by her teammates, NSCAA/adidas College Scholar all-West Region team, NSCAA/adidas Women's Soccer Scholar All-America College Division First Team.

At one point during her senior season, the team was ranked No. 1 in the Midwest Region and ranked nationally in the top 10. Stroup finished her MSU Billings career as the school record holder for career goals, assists, points, game winning goals, and games started.

Stroup is also very active with the Magic City Soccer Club. Since the spring of 2004, she has coached teams ranging in ages from girls u12 to girls u15. This past spring Stroup helped coach the girls' u13 and u14 teams, and will continue with the u14 team in the spring of 2009 through their u15 season. She also serves as the Assistant Camp Director for Yellowjacket Soccer Camps.

Stroup holds a USSF National "C" Coaching License and is currently a graduate student at MSU Billings pursuing a degree in Master of Education - School Counseling Option. She is married to Garret Stroup, a 2006 graduate of MSU Billings.
