MSUB WOMEN'S SOCCER
2008 Game Notes

BRIEFLY

MSUB continues its six game home stand Wednesday and Saturday as it begins Great Northwest Athletic Conference action. The Yellowjackets battle Central Washington Wednesday at 4 p.m., at the MSUB Soccer Field and host No. 17 Seattle Pacific, Saturday at 1 p.m.

SCOUTING MSUB

The Montana State Billings Yellowjacket women's soccer team enters the week with a 5-2 record and look to get off to a quick start in conference play. The Jackets are fresh off a pair of 1-0 victories in the last two weeks over the University of Mary and Carroll College. MSUB has not allowed a goal in 231:33, the longest streak of the season.

Leading the way for the Jackets this season is Kari Foreman, Chelsea Libby, Melissa Carlson and Mandy Ploskonka who all have four points. Libby, Foreman and Carlson each have two goals, while Ploskonka leads the team with four assists.

In goal, the Jackets are led by Jordan Fenwick who as played and started all seven games. She has a 5-2 record with three shutouts to go along with a 1.52 goals against average and 33 saves. She has allowed 10 goals on the year. Brittany Knudtzon also has seen action with one save.

RECAPPING LAST WEEK

The Yellowjackets posted their second shutout in as many games and third of the season as they defeated Carroll College 1-0 in the only game of the week this past Friday. With under seven minutes left in regulation, the Jackets scored on a nice pass from Mandy Ploskonka to Chelsea Libby for the game winner. It was second game in a row that the Jackets scored in the final 10 minutes of regulation to win.

SCOUTING CENTRAL WASHINGTON

The Wildcats enter the week with a 3-2-2 record and a 0-1 record in the GNAC. CWU dropped a 2-1 home decision to Saint Martin's Sept. 20. Prior to that, CWU was 3-0-2 in its previous five games. The Wildcats are led by Serena Tomaso who has three goals to lead the team. She has 11 shots with eight on goal and one game winner. Brittany Franks has two goals and one assist, while Kaycie Hutchins leads the team with three assists, a goal and 22 shots.

Defensively, the Wildcats are led by goalkeeper, Amber Easterbrook who has played every minute this season. She has a 3-2-2 record with four shutouts and 28 saves. Easterbrook has a 0.67 goals against average and has allowed just five scores on the year.

INSIDE THE SERIES

The Wildcats lead the all-time series 6-2, including a 3-0 victory in Ellensburg last season. MSUB returned the favor in Billings

with a 2-1 victory last year as well. All three goals came in the second half as MSUB jumped out to a 2-0 lead. The Wildcats scored a late goal in the game, but were unable to get any closer.

SCOUTING SEATTLE PACIFIC

The Falcons enter the week ranked 17th nationally after losing at Western Washington and defeating Saint Martin's in their last two games by the score of 1-0. Prior to the WWU game, the Falcons were 6-0-1 and ranked as high as fourth nationally.

Leading the way for SPU is Meredith Teague and Amanda Johnson each who have four goals thus far. Teague leads the team with six assists and 14 points. Johnson has three assists and leads the team with 41 shots, 17 on goal and three game winners. Five other Falcons have one or two goals as well as the team has 16 for the year compared to just four for the opponents.

In goal, SPU has used two keepers for the season. Jesslyn Rahm leads the team with a 4-0-1 record, three shutouts, 14 saves and a 0.55 goals against average. Maddie Dickinson has a 0.25 goals against average with seven saves and a 3-1 record. Combined, the team has an impressive 0.42 GAA with just four goals allowed compared to 21 saves and six shutouts.

INSIDE THE SERIES

The Falcons lead the all-time series 4-0 including two victories last season. MSUB has never scored on SPU and the Falcons own a 12-0 advantage in goals.

The last two games have come down to the wire for the Yellowjackets. MSUB has scored two goals in the final 10 minutes of each of the last two games to win both 1-0. Against Mary, the Jackets scored in the 83rd minute, while MSUB defeated Carroll College last week with a goal in the 84th minute.

JACKETS SELECTED THIRD

MSUB has been selected third in the GNAC preseason poll by the league coaches. Defending conference champion and 2007 NCAA Final Four Seattle Pacific was selected first, followed by Western Washington, MSUB, Central Washington, Northwest Nazarene and Western Oregon tied for fifth and Saint Martin's was picked seventh.

MSUB SIGNS EIGHT

The Montana State Billings women's soccer program signed eight players during the offseason to go along with 16 returners. All eight incoming players will have the opportunity to make an immediate impact.

MSUB SOCCER FIELD WINS AWARD

The newly renovated MSUB Soccer Field won a NCAA Community Engagement Award as the top community relations effort submitted from the Great Northwest Athletic Conference. MSUB was one of 22 schools to receive the award and also received a \$500 grant from the NCAA to be used in future community-engagement efforts.

Don Trentham enters his seventh year as head women's soccer coach at MSU Billings in 2008. Under Trentham's direction the

program has gone 53-49-8. He is the most successful coach in the history of the program in terms of both total wins and winning percentage, and his teams have posted the only three winning seasons in team history. In addition to his role as the head women's coach, Trentham is in charge of the fundraising and the development of Yellowjacket Field, which in the spring of 2008 received a facelift with the addition of a state-of-the-art synthetic turf playing field.

Trentham attended Columbia College (Missouri) and played for head coach Dan Hogan, who is now head coach at University of Southern Indiana. At Columbia he was part of an NAIA program that was consistently ranked in the top-20, won two conference tournament championships and twice advanced to the regional tournament. In his senior year, the team finished 17-5 and was ranked ninth in the nation.

Trentham began his collegiate coaching career as an assistant at Embry-Riddle University in Daytona Beach, Florida where he had the chance to work two seasons with one of the finest soccer tacticians in the country – David Gregson. At Embry-Riddle he assisted in guiding the team to a #16 NAIA National Ranking in the final poll of 1999 season, two NAIA Regional Tournament appearances and a Florida Sun Conference regular season championship.

"I've been very fortunate to have played for and coached with two great people," says Trentham. "Much of what I learned about the game came from Coach Hogan and David Gregson. Had it not been for those guys, I don't know if I'd be

coaching today."

Aside from his head coaching duties with the team at MSU Billings, Trentham also plays an active role in developing players throughout the state and the region. Over the past three years he has served as the u13 and u14 girls head coach for the Magic City Soccer Club, guiding three teams to Montana State Youth Soccer Championships. In the past he has also coached in the Olympic Development Program serving as the ODP girl's head coach for Montana, as well as an ODP staff coach for Region IV. Furthermore, he holds many camps, clinics, tournaments, and leagues during the course of the year for both adult and youth players throughout the state.

Trentham earned his Bachelor of Arts in Education from Columbia College and a Master of Education in Sport Management from East Stroudsburg University. He holds an "A" and "National Goalkeeping" licenses from the United States Soccer Federation, as well as an Advanced National license from the National Soccer Coaches Association of America.



The 2008 season will be Stroup's second as the Yellowjackets' women's soccer assistant coach. She is a 2007 cum laude graduate

from MSU Billings, earning a Bachelor of Arts Degree in psychology with a minor in coaching.

"Ally continues to be a valuable asset to the soccer program here at MSUB," said Head Coach Don Trentham. "She has worked very hard the past year in making the transition from player to coach and is settling in nicely in her role as assistant coach. She knows the game very well and has a tremendous passion for MSUB soccer, and it is exciting to watch her pass on that knowledge and passion to the players."

As a player, Stroup was a four year

starter and two-time captain for the Yellowjackets. Her freshmen season she was named to the NSCAA/adidas All-West Region Second Team. As a junior, she received the following honors: MSU Billings Most Valuable Student-Athlete, Heartland all-conference team, scholar-athlete by her teammates, and ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District VII Second Team. For her senior season, she received the following honors: ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District VII second team, Dakrtonics all-Midwest Region, scholar-athlete and MVP by her teammates, NSCAA/adidas College Scholar all-West Region team, NSCAA/adidas Women's Soccer Scholar All-America College Division First Team.

At one point during her senior season, the team was ranked No. 1 in the Midwest Region and ranked nationally in the top 10. Stroup finished her MSU Billings career as the school record holder for career goals, assists, points, game winning goals, and games started.

Stroup is also very active with the Magic City Soccer Club. Since the spring of 2004, she has coached teams ranging in ages from girls u12 to girls u15. This past spring Stroup helped coach the girls' u13 and u14 teams, and will continue with the u14 team in the spring of 2009 through their u15 season. She also serves as the Assistant Camp Director for Yellowjacket Soccer Camps.

Stroup holds a USSF National "C" Coaching License and is currently a graduate student at MSU Billings pursuing a degree in Master of Education - School Counseling Option. She is married to Garret Stroup, a 2006 graduate of MSU Billings.
