MSUB WOMEN'S SOCCER
2008 Game Notes

BRIEFLY

MSUB heads on the road this week for just the second time this season. The Jackets begin the final stretch of the season with six of their last nine games away from home. Thursday the Yellowjackets head to No. 13 Western Washington in the first night game of the season and then look for revenge on Saturday at Central Washington at 11 a.m. The Wildcats beat MSUB earlier this year at the COT Field, 2-0. MSUB stands at 7-4 on the year and evened its record to 2-2 in conference play with two huge, come-from-behind victories this past week over Saint Martin's and Western Oregon.

SCOUTING MSUB

The Montana State Billings Yellowjacket women's soccer team enters the week with a 7-4 record and a 2-2 record in conference play. The Jackets dropped their first two conference games at home by a margin of 5-0, then last week scored five goals en route to defeating Saint Martin's 3-2 in overtime and defeating Western Oregon 2-1. MSUB came from behind in both games for the wins.

Leading the way for the Jackets this season is Kari Foreman, who has four goals and eight points thus far. She leads the team with 21 shots and 13 on goal and has two games winners. Melissa Carlson is second on the team with three goals and one assist. Mandy Ploskonka leads the team with four assists and one goal. Seven different Yellowjackets have scored goals this season.

In goal, the Jackets are led by Jordan Fenwick who has played and started in 10 games. She has a 6-4 record with three shut-outs to go along with a 1.77 goals against average and 43 saves. She has allowed 15 goals on the year. Brittany Knudtson earned her first start of the season Saturday against Western Oregon and carries a 1-0 record with a 0.62 gaa and seven saves. She has played in a total of three games this season.

RECAPPING LAST WEEK

Starting a 0-3 start in conference play with seven minutes left and a 2-0 home deficit to Saint Martin's, the Yellowjackets rallied to score two goals in the final seven minutes, including a goal by Kari Foreman with just 19 seconds left in regulation to tie the game and force overtime. In the overtime period, the Jackets score the game winner as Foreman scored her second goal of the game, this time with just 23 seconds left in the first overtime for a 3-2 lead. On Saturday, the Jackets fell behind early, but rallied for two first half goals for a 2-1 victory over Western Oregon. Mandy Ploskonka scored her first goal of the season for the game winner off a corner kick, 32 minutes into the contest. The equalizer came as Carly Valentine scored her first collegiate goal to go along with her first collegiate assist on Thursday against Saint Martin's on the Foreman game winner in overtime.

seven. WWU, ranked 13th nationally and first in the NSCAA/adidas West Region Poll, are 8-2 on the year and a perfect 4-0 in conference play. During the Vikings' five game winning streak, they have outscored their opponents 11-3. The game against MSUB will be the final game of a four game home stand.

Leading the way for the Vikings this season is Claire Morgan who leads the team with six goals and five assists. She has a team-high 46 shots and 16 on goal with four game winners. Molly Shannon is second on the team with four goals, while Emily Frankland leads the team with four assist and has three goals. WWU has 18 goals on the year to just eight by its opponents.

In goal, Kylie Broadbent has played started in all 10 games. She has an 0.80 goals against average with 37 saves in 902:10 minutes of action. Broadbent also has four shutouts and an 8-2 record.

INSIDE THE SERIES

The Vikings own a 4-0-1 record in the series that dates back to 1998. WWU went 1-0-1 against the Yellowjackets last year as the teams played to a 2-2 draw in Bellingham and WWU won 2-0 in Billings. In the game in Bellingham, the Jackets held a 2-0 lead at halftime and WWU scored two second half goals, including a 90th minute goal at the 89:11 mark to force overtime and the eventual tie. In Billings, Claire Morgan scored one and assisted on the other for the 2-0 victory for the Vikings.

SCOUTING CENTRAL WASHINGTON

The Wildcats enter the week with a 5-4-2 record overall and a 2-3 record in conference play. CWU has dropped two straight and three of six. MSUB and CWU played just

over two weeks ago in Billings as CWU won 2-0. The Wildcats are led by Lynde Clarke and Serena Tomaso who each have three goals and one assist on the year. Kaycie Hutchins leads the team with four assists. The 'Cats have outscored their opponents 17-10 and have a 13-9 lead in assists.

In goal, Amber Easterbrook has played and started in all 11 games. She has a 5-4-2 record with six shutouts and a 0.87 goals against average. Easterbrook has 50 saves on the year.

INSIDE THE SERIES

It was the Yellowjackets' first conference victory of the season. Even more impressive, the Jackets scored the equalizer with just 19 seconds left in regulation and won the game with 23 seconds left in the first overtime.

VALENTINE'S DAY

Sophomore Carly Valentine scored her first collegiate assist Thursday in a 3-2 victory over Saint Martin's. She followed that up with the equalizing goal in the first half of a 2-1 victory over Western Oregon Saturday. Her goal came just 75 seconds after WOU took a 1-0 lead.

FOREMAN NAMED POW AGAIN

Sophomore midfielder Kari Foreman was named co-GNAC Player of the Week again this week, her second time this season. Foreman scored two goals helping the Jackets to a 2-0 record in conference play last week. Foreman scored the equalizing goal with 19 seconds left in regulation and scored the game winner with 23 seconds left in the first overtime in a 3-2 victory over Saint Martin's Thursday. Foreman leads the team with four goals on the year. This week Foreman shares the honor with Jill Jensen who scored five goals last week for Saint Martin's.

TAKE IT TO THE CORNER

The Yellowjackets have 39 corner kicks this season compared to 36 by the opponents. However, MSUB has a 24-12 lead in corner kicks in the second half and the opponents have a 23-14 advantage in the first half.

PENALTY FREE JACKETS

Not one Yellowjacket player has been carded through seven games this season. MSUB had just four during the 2007 season, but two were in the first six games.

Don Trentham enters his seventh year as head women's soccer coach at MSU Billings in 2008. Under Trentham's direction the

program has gone 53-49-8. He is the most successful coach in the history of the program in terms of both total wins and winning percentage, and his teams have posted the only three winning seasons in team history. In addition to his role as the head women's coach, Trentham is in charge of the fundraising and the development of Yellowjacket Field, which in the spring of 2008 received a facelift with the addition of a state-of-the-art synthetic turf playing field.

Trentham attended Columbia College (Missouri) and played for head coach Dan Hogan, who is now head coach at University of Southern Indiana. At Columbia he was part of an NAIA program that was consistently ranked in the top-20, won two conference tournament championships and twice advanced to the regional tournament. In his senior year, the team finished 17-5 and was ranked ninth in the nation.

Trentham began his collegiate coaching career as an assistant at Embry-Riddle University in Daytona Beach, Florida where he had the chance to work two seasons with one of the finest soccer tacticians in the country – David Gregson. At Embry-Riddle he assisted in guiding the team to a #16 NAIA National Ranking in the final poll of 1999 season, two NAIA Regional Tournament appearances and a Florida Sun Conference regular season championship.

"I've been very fortunate to have played for and coached with two great people," says Trentham. "Much of what I learned about the game came from Coach Hogan and David Gregson. Had it not been for those guys, I don't know if I'd be

coaching today."

Aside from his head coaching duties with the team at MSU Billings, Trentham also plays an active role in developing players throughout the state and the region. Over the past three years he has served as the u13 and u14 girls head coach for the Magic City Soccer Club, guiding three teams to Montana State Youth Soccer Championships. In the past he has also coached in the Olympic Development Program serving as the ODP girl's head coach for Montana, as well as an ODP staff coach for Region IV. Furthermore, he holds many camps, clinics, tournaments, and leagues during the course of the year for both adult and youth players throughout the state.

Trentham earned his Bachelor of Arts in Education from Columbia College and a Master of Education in Sport Management from East Stroudsburg University. He holds an "A" and "National Goalkeeping" licenses from the United States Soccer Federation, as well as an Advanced National license from the National Soccer Coaches Association of America.



The 2008 season will be Stroup's second as the Yellowjackets' women's soccer assistant coach. She is a 2007 cum laude graduate

from MSU Billings, earning a Bachelor of Arts Degree in psychology with a minor in coaching.

"Ally continues to be a valuable asset to the soccer program here at MSUB," said Head Coach Don Trentham. "She has worked very hard the past year in making the transition from player to coach and is settling in nicely in her role as assistant coach. She knows the game very well and has a tremendous passion for MSUB soccer, and it is exciting to watch her pass on that knowledge and passion to the players."

As a player, Stroup was a four year

starter and two-time captain for the Yellowjackets. Her freshmen season she was named to the NSCAA/adidas All-West Region Second Team. As a junior, she received the following honors: MSU Billings Most Valuable Student-Athlete, Heartland all-conference team, scholar-athlete by her teammates, and ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District VII Second Team. For her senior season, she received the following honors: ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District VII second team, Dakrtonics all-Midwest Region, scholar-athlete and MVP by her teammates, NSCAA/adidas College Scholar all-West Region team, NSCAA/adidas Women's Soccer Scholar All-America College Division First Team.

At one point during her senior season, the team was ranked No. 1 in the Midwest Region and ranked nationally in the top 10. Stroup finished her MSU Billings career as the school record holder for career goals, assists, points, game winning goals, and games started.

Stroup is also very active with the Magic City Soccer Club. Since the spring of 2004, she has coached teams ranging in ages from girls u12 to girls u15. This past spring Stroup helped coach the girls' u13 and u14 teams, and will continue with the u14 team in the spring of 2009 through their u15 season. She also serves as the Assistant Camp Director for Yellowjacket Soccer Camps.

Stroup holds a USSF National "C" Coaching License and is currently a graduate student at MSU Billings pursuing a degree in Master of Education - School Counseling Option. She is married to Garret Stroup, a 2006 graduate of MSU Billings.
