MSUB WOMEN'S SOCCER
2008 Game Notes

BRIEFLY

MSUB returns home looking to get back on the winning track after two tough road losses last week. The Jackets stand at 7-6 overall and 2-4 in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference. The Jackets host Northwest Nazarene Thursday and play cross-town rival Rocky Mountain Saturday in the seventh annual Rimrock Cup.

SCOUTING MSUB

The Montana State Billings Yellowjacket women's soccer team enters the week with a 7-6 record and a 2-4 record in conference play. The Jackets dropped their first two conference games at home by a margin of 5-0, then scored five goals en route to defeating Saint Martin's 3-2 in overtime and defeating Western Oregon 2-1. MSUB played No. 13 Western Washington to a 1-0 score for 89:30 and fell 2-0, then dropped a heartbreaking 2-1 decision at Central Washington last week.

Leading the way for the Jackets this season is Kari Foreman, who has four goals and eight points thus far. She is third on the team with 21 shots and second on the team with 13 on goal and has two games winners. Melissa Carlson is second on the team with three goals and two assists. Mandy Ploskonka leads the team with four assists and one goal. Seven different Yellowjackets have scored goals this season.

In goal, the Jackets are led by Jordan Fenwick who has played and started in 12 games. She has a 6-4 record with three shut-outs to go along with a 1.81 goals against average and 61 saves. She has allowed 21 goals on the year. Brittany Knudtson earned her first start of the season against Western Oregon and carries a 1-0 record with a 0.62 gaa and seven saves. She has played in a total of three games this season.

RECAPPING LAST WEEK

After two impressive conference victories to even its record at 2-2, the women's soccer team had the difficult task of traveling to No. 13 Western Washington. The Jackets were down 1-0 through 89 minutes of the game and WWU scored a late goal for a 2-0 victory. MSUB then looked to avenge an early season loss at Central Washington. The Jackets got down 1-0 right before the half, but a quick goal to begin the second half evened the score. CWU scored the game winner on a penalty kick.

SCOUTING NORTHWEST NAZARENE

The Crusaders enter the game with a 1-11-1 record overall and a 0-5 record in conference play. NNU has lost six straight and been outscored 27-4 during that span. The lone goal for the Crusaders came against the College of Idaho, a 2-0 home decision Sept. 17.

The Crusaders are led by Stacey Beckman who leads the team with three goals and six points. She also is tied for second on the team in shots with 15. Marie Smith has two goals and four

INSIDE THE SERIES

SCOUTING ROCKY MOUNTAIN

The Battlin' Bears enter the week with an 8-3 record. The Bears will play Westminster College at the COT Field Thursday, prior to MSUB's game versus NNU. The Jackets and the Bears battle Saturday at 3:30 p.m.

Leading the way for the Battlin' Bears is Abby Jenkins and Anna Clark who each have seven goals on the year. Clark is second on the team with five assists, while Allie Beckers leads the team with eight assists.

In goal, Vanessa Peters leads the way as she has 25 saves in 10 games and a 1.10 goals against average.

THE SEVENTH ANNUAL RIMROCK CUP

The Yellowjackets lead the all-time series, 9-6-1 and have a 4-1-1 record in the past six games. Last season, MSUB posted a 2-1 victory over the Bears as Chelsea Libby scored the first goal 34 minutes in and Mandy Ploskonka added the game winner in the 62nd minute. Prior to the game against Rocky Saturday, the Jackets will honor three outstanding seniors who all have had impressive careers. Saturday will be the second to final home game for Melissa Carlson, Mandy Ploskonka and Sara Gress. Entering the week, this class has a 40-27-4 record in their career.

CLUTCH JACKETS

The Yellowjackets scored two goals in the last seven minutes of regulation and scored a goal in overtime for a dramatic 3-2 victory over Saint Martin's Oct. 2. It was the Yellowjackets' first conference victory of the season. Even more impressive, the Jackets scored the equalizer with just 19 seconds left in regulation and won the game with 23 seconds left in the first overtime.

VALENTINE'S DAY

Sophomore Carly Valentine scored her first collegiate assist Oct. 2 in a 3-2 victory over Saint Martin's. She followed that up with the equalizing goal in the first half of a 2-1 victory over Western Oregon Oct. 4. Her goal came just 75 seconds after WOU took a 1-0 lead.

FOREMAN NAMED POW AGAIN

Sophomore midfielder Kari Foreman was named co-GNAC Player of the Week Oct. 6, her second time this season. Foreman scored two goals helping the Jackets to a 2-0 record in conference play last week. Foreman scored the equalizing goal with 19 seconds left in regulation and scored the game winner with 23 seconds left in the first overtime in a 3-2 victory over Saint Martin's Oct. 2. Foreman leads the team with four goals on the year. This week Foreman shares the honor with Jill Jensen who scored five goals last week for Saint Martin's.

TAKE IT TO THE CORNER

The Yellowjackets have 44 corner kicks this season compared to 39 by the opponents. However, MSUB has a 27-12 lead in corner kicks in the second half and the opponents have a 26-16 advantage in the first half.

PENALTY FREE JACKETS

Not one Yellowjacket player has been carded through seven games this season. MSUB had just four during the 2007 season, but two were in the first six games.

Don Trentham enters his seventh year as head women's soccer coach at MSU Billings in 2008. Under Trentham's direction the

program has gone 53-49-8. He is the most successful coach in the history of the program in terms of both total wins and winning percentage, and his teams have posted the only three winning seasons in team history. In addition to his role as the head women's coach, Trentham is in charge of the fundraising and the development of Yellowjacket Field, which in the spring of 2008 received a facelift with the addition of a state-of-the-art synthetic turf playing field.

Trentham attended Columbia College (Missouri) and played for head coach Dan Hogan, who is now head coach at University of Southern Indiana. At Columbia he was part of an NAIA program that was consistently ranked in the top-20, won two conference tournament championships and twice advanced to the regional tournament. In his senior year, the team finished 17-5 and was ranked ninth in the nation.

Trentham began his collegiate coaching career as an assistant at Embry-Riddle University in Daytona Beach, Florida where he had the chance to work two seasons with one of the finest soccer tacticians in the country – David Gregson. At Embry-Riddle he assisted in guiding the team to a #16 NAIA National Ranking in the final poll of 1999 season, two NAIA Regional Tournament appearances and a Florida Sun Conference regular season championship.

"I've been very fortunate to have played for and coached with two great people," says Trentham. "Much of what I learned about the game came from Coach Hogan and David Gregson. Had it not been for those guys, I don't know if I'd be

coaching today."

Aside from his head coaching duties with the team at MSU Billings, Trentham also plays an active role in developing players throughout the state and the region. Over the past three years he has served as the u13 and u14 girls head coach for the Magic City Soccer Club, guiding three teams to Montana State Youth Soccer Championships. In the past he has also coached in the Olympic Development Program serving as the ODP girl's head coach for Montana, as well as an ODP staff coach for Region IV. Furthermore, he holds many camps, clinics, tournaments, and leagues during the course of the year for both adult and youth players throughout the state.

Trentham earned his Bachelor of Arts in Education from Columbia College and a Master of Education in Sport Management from East Stroudsburg University. He holds an "A" and "National Goalkeeping" licenses from the United States Soccer Federation, as well as an Advanced National license from the National Soccer Coaches Association of America.



The 2008 season will be Stroupe's second as the Yellowjackets' women's soccer assistant coach. She is a 2007 cum laude graduate

from MSU Billings, earning a Bachelor of Arts Degree in psychology with a minor in coaching.

"Ally continues to be a valuable asset to the soccer program here at MSUB," said Head Coach Don Trentham. "She has worked very hard the past year in making the transition from player to coach and is settling in nicely in her role as assistant coach. She knows the game very well and has a tremendous passion for MSUB soccer, and it is exciting to watch her pass on that knowledge and passion to the players."

As a player, Stroupe was a four year

starter and two-time captain for the Yellowjackets. Her freshmen season she was named to the NSCAA/adidas All-West Region Second Team. As a junior, she received the following honors: MSU Billings Most Valuable Student-Athlete, Heartland all-conference team, scholar-athlete by her teammates, and ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District VII Second Team. For her senior season, she received the following honors: ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District VII second team, Dakrtonics all-Midwest Region, scholar-athlete and MVP by her teammates, NSCAA/adidas College Scholar all-West Region team, NSCAA/adidas Women's Soccer Scholar All-America College Division First Team.

At one point during her senior season, the team was ranked No. 1 in the Midwest Region and ranked nationally in the top 10. Stroupe finished her MSU Billings career as the school record holder for career goals, assists, points, game winning goals, and games started.

Stroupe is also very active with the Magic City Soccer Club. Since the spring of 2004, she has coached teams ranging in ages from girls u12 to girls u15. This past spring Stroupe helped coach the girls' u13 and u14 teams, and will continue with the u14 team in the spring of 2009 through their u15 season. She also serves as the Assistant Camp Director for Yellowjacket Soccer Camps.

Stroupe holds a USSF National "C" Coaching License and is currently a graduate student at MSU Billings pursuing a degree in Master of Education - School Counseling Option. She is married to Garret Stroupe, a 2006 graduate of MSU Billings.
