### Yellowjackets Look for Alaskan Split

- Montana State Billings women's basketball is coming off a 85-63 setback to the 12th ranked Seawolves of Alaska Anchorage Thursday night. They look to rebound and stay near the top of GNAC standings as they take on the Nanooks of Alaska Fairbanks, Saturday, Jan. 16. The game tips-off at 7 p.m. from the Patty Center in Fairbanks. Live stats and game broadcasts will be available through the UAF website.
- The Yellowjackets (8-5, 1-1) are trying to rebound from a dismal night in Anchorage on Thursday evening. An outstanding shooting performance, 47.6 percent from the field, 53.8 percent from three-point range and 88.9 percent from the charity stripe, was marred by a season-high 34 turnovers, which included 26 steals by the Seawolves. The Yellowjackets never led during the game but managed to keep the first half close, going into the break down just nine. Anchorage opened up the second half on a 23-8 run that stretched the lead to 24, 62-38. The Seawolves turned the 34 turnovers into 42 points and managed to outscore the Jackets in the paint 36-22. MSUB had two players in double figures, Kayla Ryan dropped 18 points and collected six rebounds and a career-high five blocks, while Sarah McNamee had 15 points on 5-of-7 shooting including a perfect 4-of-4 from behind the arc. Kelcy Lott saw action for the first time this season, scoring two points and grabbing one rebound and one assist in ten minutes of play. Lott was called to action after starting the season with redshirt status, due to extensive injuries to other teammates.
- Alaska Fairbanks (1-12, 0-2) was idol Thursday night, but have dropped twelve straight since opening the season with a 66-65 victory over Hawaii-Hilo Nov. 17. The Nanooks dropped their conference openers last week, falling to Western Washington, 92-46, in Bellingham and then 82-72 to Central Washington in Ellensburg. Lakeshia Levi leads UAF in scoring and rebounds, averaging 16.5 points and 7.9 boards per game. UAF is shooting 33.6 percent from the floor this season and have been outscored by their opponents by 21 points on average.
- MSUB leads the overall series against UAF, 38-11. The Yellowjackets have dominated the Nanooks both on the road (18-6) and at home (19-3). Entering this matchup, MSUB has won five-straight against the Nanooks including their last three in Fairbanks. UAF last defeated the Jackets on Jan. 3, 2002 in Hawaii, and were last victorious at home on Dec. 21, 2001.
- Once the Yellowjackets return home from Fairbanks, they will have just a few days to prepare before heading back out on the road to take on the current 21st nationally-ranked Falcons of SPU (Jan. 21) and Northwest Nazarene (Jan. 23).

Road Warriors

The Yellowjackets are entering their longest stretch of road games this season with this week's trip north. For the next two weeks, MSUB will be traveling to Alaska (Jan. 14 and 16) and then on to Washington where they will take on the current 22nd nationally ranked Falcons of Seattle Pacific (Jan. 21) and the Crusaders of Northwest Nazarene (Jan. 23). The Yellowjackets will return home Jan. 28 against Western Washington for the first of three home games.

Top Stats

MSUB currently leads the GNAC in three statistical categories and is in the top-25 in four categories nationally. MSUB leads the conference in least amount of turnovers, 16.8 per game, assist turnover ratio (1.05) and three-point fg defense (26.1). On the national scene, MSUB is 22nd in assists per game (17.7), 23rd in both assist turnover ratio and three-point fg defense and are 21st in free throw percentage (38.3).

Ryan's Reign

Yellowjacket senior forward, Kayla Ryan, ranks in the top of the GNAC in rebounds per game with 9.3 and free throw percentage with an 88.1 average. Her FT average also ranks 18th in the nation and is 6.5 percent better than the next closest player in the conference (Dara Zack, Saint Martin's, 81.6)

Milestone Watch

With the victory over Saint Martin's Jan. 7, MSUB head coach, Kevin Woodin, recorded his 96th career victory. With four more wins, coach Woodin will become the third coach in MSUB women's basketball history to record 100 wins at the school. With six more victories, Woodin would tie Ted Anderson (1982-87) for second on the school's all-time wins list with 102.

A Winning Attitude

Among active Division II coaches, coach Kevin Woodin entered the season ranked 39th in career winning percentages. His 88-53 record at the beginning of the season gave him a .624 winning percentage. With the three wins already, Coach Woodin holds a .632 win percentage.

Ryan Earns GNAC Weekly Honor

Kayla Ryan earned GNAC POW (Jan. 4) after scoring 36 points and grabbing 18 rebounds as the Yellowjackets posted a pair of double-digit victories over Rocky and Chadron State. The Big Timber, MT native shot 72.2 percent from the floor, making 13-of-18, and also made 9-of-10 from the charity stripe in the two victories. She had 22 points and 10 rebounds against Chadron State on Sunday, recording her league-best seventh double-double of the season. Ryan is averaging 16.0 points and 9.5 rebounds per game this season.

**Ryan Named All-Tournament**

- Junior, Kayla Ryan, was named to the 2009 Hyatt Place Thanksgiving Classic All-Tournament team this past weekend. Ryan scored 40 points and grabbed 21 rebounds in the splits against UC-CS and Adams State. The 20 points in both games were season-highs as was the 12 boards in the victory over the Mountain Lions.

**Kautzmann Garners POW Honors**

- The 5-10 sophomore scored 63 points and also had 21 rebounds, five assists and seven steals as the Yellowjackets won three games in seven days to start the season 3-0, all by double-digit margins.
- The Nampa, ID native shot 56.1 percent from the floor (23-41), 43.8 percent from the three-point line (7-16) and 90.9 percent from the free throw line (10-11) in wins over UC-Colorado Springs, University of Mary and Chadron State College
- Against UCCS, Kautzmann scored 24 points to help lead MSUB to a 91-57 rout of the Mountain Lions. In the win over Mary, she scored a career-high 26 points and five boards. Against Chadron State, Kautzmann set another career-high, this time in rebounds, with 11.

**Let the Record Show**

- Sophomore guard Kalli Stanhope ignited a Yellowjackets victory in the season opener (Nov. 15), scoring a career-high 28 points which included a school record eight three-pointers, in defeating UC-Colorado Springs, 91-57.
- She broke the previous record of seven which was held by four other Yellowjackets, including the school's all-time leading scorer, Alira Carpenter.
- Stanhope's eight trey's were part of 16 drained by the team, just one shy of the school record, 17.

**Refuse to Lose... Home Openers**

- The Nov. 6 home opener win was not only the second consecutive season opener victory, it was the 17th season in which the Yellowjackets have won their home opener.
- To find the last time MSUB dropped a home opener, you have to travel back to the 1991-92 season when the Yellowjackets fell to Eastern New Mexico, 72-70, on Nov. 22.

**Basketball Battles Breast Cancer**

- The women's basketball team is doing its part in the fight against breast cancer. During the first six home games this season, MSUB is taking donations for every three-pointer that is made by the team or just general donations.
- 75 percent of the proceeds go to a local Billings family that has amassed the expensive medical bills that go into fighting the disease. The other 25 percent goes toward the women's basketball program.

**2009-10 MSUB WOMEN'S BASKETBALL**

- Coach Kevin Woodin announced the signings of Bobbi Knudsen and Corie Smith to play for the Yellowjackets starting in 2010-2011.
- Knudsen, a 5-8 guard from Malta High School, is a three year letterwinner in basketball and has also earned letters for cross country and track. For her career, Knudsen has averaged 11.0 points per game with 5.5 rebounds, and has shot 59 percent from the floor.
- Last season, Knudsen was named to the all-conference and all-state teams in helping Malta to district and divisional championships, leading to a runner-up finish at the state tournament. In all, she has helped MHS to three consecutive district and divisional titles with one state championship in 2007.
- Smith, a 5-11 forward, has had a successful basketball and track career at Belgrade High School in Belgrade, MT. Last season, Smith led the Central 'A' Conference in 12 rebounds per game and was top-ten in field goal percentage (45.6 percent), steals (35) and scoring (9.89 ppg). In 2007-08, Smith was named honorable mention all-conference and then last season, earned second team all-conference while being named to the first team Central 'A' all-divisional tournament team. Smith also helped lead BHS to a divisional championship in 2009.

**Yellowjackets Predicted Seventh**

- Montana State Billings women's basketball was picked to finish seventh in this year's GNAC standings according to the preseason coaches poll. The Jackets were selected in front of Central Washington and Alaska Fairbanks. Last season, MSUB finished 8-8 in the conference and looks to build on that record with the outside shooting. Ahead of the Yellowjackets, Alaska Anchorage was the preseason favorite, followed by Seattle Pacific, Northwest Nazarene, Western Washington, Saint Martin's and Western Oregon.

**2009-2010 Season Preview**

- The Montana State Billings women's basketball team is looking forward to the 2009-2010 season. The Yellowjackets return two starters and seven letter winners from a team that placed fifth in the always competitive Great Northwest Athletic Conference a year ago. The 'Jackets face a very challenging schedule this season, but one that should prepare them for competition in one of the premier conferences in the country.
- One of the toughest tasks this season will be replacing last years' senior class, especially Alira Carpenter. Carpenter concluded her illustrious career at MSUB, scoring 2,000 career points to become the first player in school history, male or female, to complete the feat. Also gone are Jen Smith and Jetton Meadors who combined to score over 16 points per game last season.
- All seven returners are expected to make an impact on this year's squad, especially the two seniors, Shantell Marquis and Rachel Hansen. Both will team with Kayla Ryan and Mandy Jacobs as team captains this season. Marquis, one of two starters from last year, averaged 7.6 points in 30.7 minutes per game. She also led the team in blocked shots (29), assists (106) and rebounds per game (5.6). MSUB looks

forward to the return of Hansen as she missed most of last season with an injury.

- them all to make an impact right away. "Each of the returners has worked very hard to improve their game this off season and I'm excited to see the progress play out on the court," Woodin said.
- The program will see plenty of fresh faces this season as coach Woodin welcomes junior transfer Sarah McNamee and four other freshmen to the team. McNamee, a 5-9 guard, joins the Yellowjackets from Carroll College where she averaged 3.4 points per game and shot 30 percent from the field. Joining McNamee are Kylee Denham, a 5-8 guard, Ashley Reed, a 6-0 forward, Kelcy Lott, a 5-6 guard and Monica Hollowell, a 5-6 guard. "This group of newcomers is very athletic and versatile," Woodin said. "They possess the talent to allow us to play the tempo we would like and are able to play multiple positions which will help us greatly."
- Coach Woodin believes that this year's strengths are going to be overall team speed, player versatility and depth from the bench. "I believe we have excellent team speed and we hope to devise a system where that can be used to its advantage," said Woodin. "We also possess several players who can play more than one position. This will help us tremendously, especially on the defensive side of the ball. Depth is strength that I hope our team will have. With five new players, the jury is still out on how they will impact our team, but I have a good feeling about this group."

### Women's Basketball History

- Women's basketball has traditionally been the most successful program at Montana State Billings. The Yellowjackets have qualified for the NCAA tournament 11 times since 1987 and 10 times since 1994. The program debuted in 1973 under the direction of head coach Nancy Monger. Since that time, nine of the eleven coaches have compiled overall winning records at MSUB.
- Hall of Fame coach Frank McCarthy has won the most games with 191 wins against 91 defeats. During his ten seasons, McCarthy guided MSUB to five NCAA tournament appearances. His 1998-1999 team enjoyed MSUB's finest season by winning a school record 25 games and advancing to the NCAA Elite Eight.
- Current coach Kevin Woodin has posted 88 wins in his first five seasons to rank third in school history, behind McCarthy (191) and Ted Anderson (102). The Yellowjackets have captured two regular season championships, one conference title and two NCAA tournament berths under Woodin's direction.
- Last season, Alira Carpenter became the first player, male or female, in MSUB history to record 2,000 career points, and just the fourth collegiate player in the state of Montana to reach the milestone. She was awarded the Little Sullivan Award, just the third MSUB athlete to win the award and the second female basketball player (Robyn Milne, 2001).
