Instructional Coordinator	\$54,720	\$63,740 x 39 years = \$2,485,860
Education Administrator	\$44,680—\$87,400	\$99,820 x 39 years = \$3,892,980
Elementary School Teacher	\$35,230—\$50,850	\$61,350 x 39 years = \$2,392,650
High School Teacher	\$30,200—\$54,630	\$61,820 x 39 years = \$2,410,980
