Financial & Investment Analysts	\$85,270 - \$93,570	\$95,080 x 39 yrs = \$3,708,120

What percentage of Accounting graduates report having a job after graduating?

Out of the 49% of 2023 Accounting graduates that we received grad data on, **95% reported being employed* after graduation.**

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION ACCOUNTING

Overview of the Accounting program:

Accounting students learn how to budget and manage money for a business, ensure that a firm is spending money wisely by making sound investments, file taxes for a corporation, and ultimately understand how a business operates and sustains itself financially. Accountants examine, analyze, and interpret accounting records to prepare financial statements, give advice, or audit and evaluate statements prepared by others. They install or advise on systems of recording costs or other financial and budgetary data.

Accountants do the following: (1) prepare detailed reports on audit findings, (2) report to management about asset utilization and audit results, and recommend changes in operations and financial activities, and (3) collect and analyze data to detect deficient controls, fraud, or non-compliance with laws, regulations, and management policies.

What makes your program unique?

The MSU Billings accounting program prepares students to sit for and pass the Certified Public Accountant Examination (CPA Exam). Courses are taught by professors with accounting work experience, and students have the ability to work in the accounting field prior to graduation through internship opportunities.

What students like most about the Accounting program:

In addition to honing technical skills, students can improve their networking skills by participating in the accounting club.

Students like the flexibility of taking classes in various modes. The accounting courses can be completed in live classroom learning or through online classes. Some are also offered live remote through videoconferencing. This flexibility allows students to complete their degree wherever they are.

Students like the accounting program because it prepares them for a variety of jobs in business. Accounting is the language of business, so an accounting degree can open doors for many different business-related jobs.

The need for accountants has increased in recent years, resulting in excellent opportunities for graduates. Also, there are many accounting internship opportunities which often open doors to full-time employment upon graduation.
