What are the average annual wages and potential lifetime earnings for professionals working in the Political Science field?

Occupation	Annual wage range in MT	Potential lifetime earnings**
Public Relations Specialist	\$46,300 – 63,040	\$66,750 x 39 = \$2,603,250
Fundraiser	\$60,470 - \$64, 490	\$64,160 x 39 = \$2,502,240
Meeting and Event Planner	\$39,840 - \$51,130	\$56,920 x 39 = \$2,219,880
Paralegal	\$56,480 – 59,810	\$60,970 x 39 = \$2,377,830

** Based on the 2023 state mean and national median wage of occupations in accordance to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. Lifetime earnings is national median wage over 39 years.

What percentage of Political Science graduates report having a job after graduating?

Out of the 50% of 2023 Political Science graduates that we received grad data on, **100% reported being employed* after graduation.**

* Employment includes employed in major, not in major, continuing ed or military
