Program Specific Information

- The Surgical Technology AAS degree program is collaboration between Missoula College of the University of Montana and City College at MSUB. The degree is earned through Missoula College, but can be completed in its entirety in Billings. - The clinical facilities in Billings are Billings Clinic and St. Vincent Health Care.
- Surgical Technology is a competitive application program. Students that are able to complete all of the program prerequisite courses by the end of the fall semester are able to apply to the program for a **spring only start**.
- The Surgical Technology program application is due **October 1** of every year. The program application can be found at <http://mc.umt.edu/health/applications/surgtech-billings/Application-Billings%202017.pdf>.
- Ten students per year will be accepted for Billings placement. Students can also request to be considered for placement in Butte and Missoula.
- BIOH 201 and 202 Human Anatomy & Physiology I and BIOH 211 and 212 Human Anatomy & Physiology II must be completed within 5 years of applying to the program.
- The college level math and writing prerequisite requirements should be completed within 10 years of applying to the program. If college level math and/or writing coursework are greater than 10 years old, the student can take the COMPASS placement exam. If the placement score(s) place into college level, the coursework shall be accepted to fulfill the prerequisite requirement(s). If the placement score(s) fall below the required standard, then the student shall remediate as needed prior to applying to the program.
- The minimum grade to be considered successful in BIOH 201 and 202 Human Anatomy & Physiology I is a 'B'. The rest of the courses in the program require a minimum grade of 'C'.
- A student may take any required course a maximum of 2 times.
- A student may apply to the program a maximum of 2 times.
- A background check will be part of the admittance process. A drug screen may also be required.
- For students that graduate in this program, Commencement exercises will be in Missoula and during this same time, graduates can take a national certification exam for Surgical Technology in Missoula.
