**Further Paramedic Information:**

- Program applications are due in July of each year.
- Approximately 18 students per year will be accepted based on their application.
- All students accepted into the program need to pass a criminal background check and drug testing to be able to go into the clinical settings. The total cost for both is around \$60.00.
- The National Registry EMT certification can fulfill the Restricted Elective requirement in Paramedic Core III. Consult with your Academic Advisor on how this certification can be processed for credit to fulfill the requirement.
- This program is also nationally accredited by Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for EMS Professions (CoAEMSP) and the Commission of Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP.)
