



## Diagnostic Medical Sonography (DMS) A.A.S.

### 2026 Competitive Application Information

**All program prerequisite courses must be completed prior to application to the core part of the program.** Students must have a selective GPA of 2.0 based on the prerequisite courses, and a grade of "C" or better in all prerequisite courses for program eligibility (*a C- is not a passing grade*).

- To make application to this program you must also be registered as a student with City College. You may apply for admission to the college online. If you have questions about the application process, call City College Jacket Student Central at (406) 247-3007.
- This program is a fall start program which means the core part of the program will start at the beginning of the fall semester, clinical rotations begin at the end of the first fall semester, and those students will graduate at the end of their second spring semester.

The City College at MSU Billings Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program is a **competitive program** and the following selection process will be used to select those students who will continue into the core courses in Diagnostic Medical Sonography starting Fall semester.

Admission into this program involves two phases:

- Phase One is a point system that will be used to select the top 25 applicants that will progress to Phase Two of the selection process. Details of the point system used for this process are included in the Diagnostic Medical Sonography Application.
- Phase Two involves a personal interview with the Diagnostic Medical Sonography Selection Committee. Interviews are usually scheduled to occur in June. Those students selected from Phase Two will start the core classes the subsequent Fall term. The decision of the selection committee is final.
- Enrollment is limited by the number of available clinical sites. Clinical sites are located throughout Montana and the region. The student will be expected to travel to their assigned clinical site. **Any expenses associated with attending clinicals are the responsibility of the student.**

### Essay Requirement

Applicants to the Diagnostic Medical Sonography program will be required to submit an essay. The essay will require students to research the field and explain the multifaceted role of a diagnostic medical sonographer. It should also include how the student believes their personal skills, attributes and aptitudes match up with the role. The committee would also like to know what drives you to pursue this career.

## Site Visit Requirement

It is important that applicants to this program have a good understanding of job responsibilities and what is involved in being a Sonographer. To ensure this understanding, as part of the application process you are required to make a site visit to an ultrasound department. You will need to schedule a site visit at a hospital ultrasound departments and spend at least eight (8) hours "job shadowing" a Sonographer. Please see the "Procedure for Scheduling a Site Visit" link on the diagnostic medical sonography website.

At the end of your site visit, be sure to have the Sonographer sign your Site Visit Signature Form. It is recommended that you do your site visit at a larger hospital as you will have a more complete understanding of Sonography as a profession. If you are re-applying to the program, you should plan to make another site visit or discuss this issue with the program director.

## Patient Care Experience

Good patient care is just as important as the quality of the ultrasound images you produce. It is recommended that you have experience in patient care. This experience can include nursing home or CNA patient care, working with patients in a hospital or clinical setting or a significant amount of volunteer work. It should involve **direct clinical** contact with patients. Not everyone is suited for working with ill patients and you need to have some idea if this is really something you want to do.
