What is the Rural Eastern Montana Nursing Expansion Program (REMNEP)?

REMNEP is a program designed to expand nursing education opportunities for individuals in Eastern Montana. It is both a prospective nursing recruitment program and a mentoring program once an individual is admitted into a nursing program.

The goal is to recruit individuals from Eastern Montana to be nurses or upskill the existing healthcare workforce to meet the nursing shortage. REMNEP participants can elect to apply for any Montana nursing program; however, only those who are accepted into MSUB or City College Nursing Programs will be provided with financial assistance.



Who is eligible to apply for REMNEP?

REMNEP is recruiting participants from the 24 Eastern Montana service counties who are:

- 17 years +
- Earned a high school diploma or equivalent
- Unemployed
- Underemployed
- Low-income
- Already working in healthcare and looking to further their career
