Required Tools (required at a minimum for all students for daily participation):

Safety glasses, workboots, hard hat, work gloves

Measuring tape – 25' minimum length, recommend 30' or 35'

Appropriate jobsite and shop attire including cold weather and wet weather gear

Required/Recommended Tools (limited supply available for loan/use if you cannot afford to provide your own):

Tool belt – good quality general purpose carpenter's tool belt with multiple pouches

Chalk box/chalk line - use blue chalk, NOT red

Hammer – recommend 20-22oz. smooth face, straight claw

Utility Knife – retractable blade

Speed Square

Slip-joint pliers

Nail set

Cat's Paw / Nail puller

Straight and Philips screwdrivers (or multi-tool with interchangeable tips)

34" or 1" wood chisel

Carpenter's Pencils / Sharpie Markers / Wax Carpenter's Crayons

It is **highly recommended** that all students provide the above-listed tools, at a minimum. Students are encouraged to mark these tools for easy individual identification. Students are welcome to provide additional small hand tools as well as a small tool box for storage in our shop. These tools will be used for several classes throughout the Construction Program. If a student purchases quality tools and equipment and takes care of these tools, they should last through our program and beyond.
