The mentor should have three years of teaching in special education and have completed training in mentoring. This training can be through their school district or through OPI training modules. Mentors will be required to have regular contact with the teacher (mentee) and to submit regular reports to the OPI Special Education Endorsement Coordinator. The mentor/mentee contact can be face-to-face or online depending on the location of the parties. If there is no mentor within the district, arrangements will be made with the Project Coordinator. The OPI Project will pay the mentors a stipend of \$750.
