In order to comply with copyright laws, a copy of the textbook must be purchased and copies of the sales slips must be turned into the DSS office. Students who are registered with DSS and receive alternative text as an accommodation should follow this process for requesting textbooks in an alternative format. 1. In order to comply with copyright laws, a copy of the textbook must be purchased. We will need a copy of your sales slip(s).
2. We will contact the publisher to see if the book is available in electronic format. If the book is not available from the publisher, we will need your copy of the book to create the alternative text. The campus print shop will chop the binding off the book. The print shop will rebind the book with plastic coiled rings, and we can generally get it back to you within 48 hours.
3. In order to ensure that your textbooks are available in alternative format when school begins, it is recommended that you request them at least three weeks in advance of when you will need them. Please contact the DSS office at 657-2283 if you have trouble identifying your textbooks.
4. Download the Read&Write software to your computer to use as a text-to-speech reader. Download the free software from the MSUB website http://www.msubillings.edu/it/is/software/readwrite/ . Students are encouraged to meet with DSS staff after downloading Read&Write and when their texbooks are converted to make sure they understand how the program works and are comfortable using the software with textbooks. An appointment can be scheduled at the time of the intake interview.
5. Alternative text are an accommodation and are provided as a means of access. They are limited to the use of the requestor and cannot be shared with other students.
