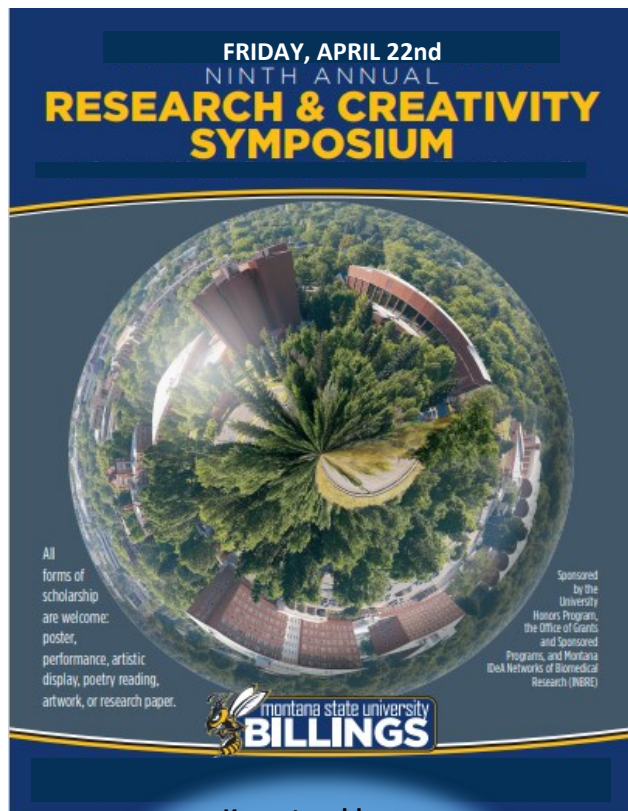

**DR. CATHY WHITLOCK** is a Regents Professor of Paleoecology at Montana State University and a Fellow of the Montana Institute on Ecosystems.

Her research interests focus on long-term climate and ecological change, and she has spent the last 40 years studying the environmental history of Greater Yellowstone as well as comparable large landscapes in New Zealand, Tasmania, and Patagonia.
