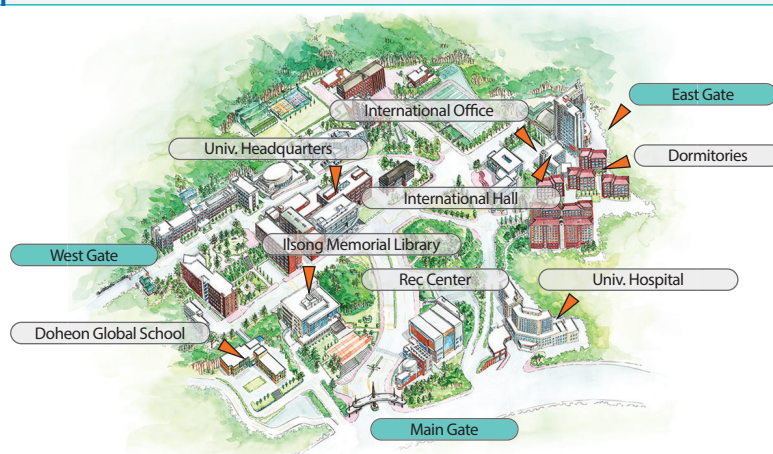

## Tuition & Scholarships

### 1) Scholarships

#### ► 1st Semester as 1st-Year Undergraduate Student

- Admission based on English language proficiency : 50% tuition reduction (one-time admission fee excluded)
- Admission based on Korean language proficiency (TOPIK) :

TOPIK Score	Tuition Reduction Rate	Book Allowance*
Level 2 or HU TOPIK	40%	200,000 KRW
Level 3	50%	400,000 KRW
Level 4	50% (+ no admission fee)	500,000 KRW
Level 5 & 6	70% (+ no admission fee)	500,000 KRW

## Korean Language Education Center (KLEC)

- Established in August 2004
- 2010 ~ Present official TOPIK center & official Korean education center for GKS students
- 650 + international students from 12 countries
- One-to-one tutor program in addition to regular classes
- Free intensive TOPIK courses (70% pass rate for level 4 within a year)

KLEC admission fee	Approx. USD 350 (KRW 400,000) (including health insurance for initial enrollment period & airport pickup)
KLEC tuition per quarter (4 sessions per year)	Approx. USD 1,100 (KRW 1,200,000)
Quarterly curriculum	10 weeks & 200 hours
Levels of proficiency	6 levels

## Facilities: Dorms, Library, Sports Centers

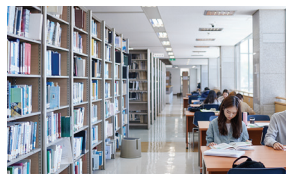
### Dormitories

- KRW 630,000 ~ KRW 1,202,000 per person per semester depending on the room type



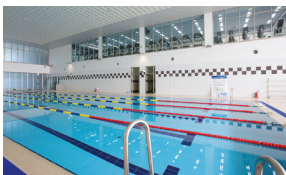
### Ilsong Memorial Library
