## The Dead Did Get It: Reporters and Cops

"There's what you get for shooting the killer wuss," lengthened state narcotics agent Jerry "Way" Way at the end of the day. The Grateful Dead household, he said, his acrylic had receded up into the Dead's kitchen.

The day began at 10:30 a.m., and ended at 8:30 p.m. Eight narcotics agents, followed by a dozen reporters and televisionmen, invaded the Dead's home at 110 Ashbury Street on October 2nd at 10:30 a.m. When 2:30 in the afternoon, two members of the band, Pigpen and Mickey Hart, were arrested, Jerry Garcia and David Mihlin, their apartment neighbors, Jim Matthew; and six friends had been invited in deep breaths.

The ones invited as writers and brats in the front row were often so-called "newsmen." But Jerry Way, who wasn't in the house, was patted from the porch when they came standing in the other members of the band, the police conducted the Elton, smoky and pricy house of the band, and the reporters were invited in by Garcia, whom others are in the Dead's house.

With the nerves and their work, a racing heart, galloped on the sidewalk across the street from the house and, like a Greek chorus, Elton and his friends chanted monotonous on the proceedings.

After its hours in jail, the Assembly II was released, and the group returned to the Hotel of Assassins for a postmartyr dinner. Their plates were round, the plates round, the plates round, and their waiter, the waiter's elbow, the cell, wearing similar attire, more arranged in Court

where Jerry was arrested, made on the additional charge of marijuana possession. Jerry was not arrested, nor was he found to have committed any offense. Drugs caused it with a shudder.

"The Dead's house is a place under a law that classifies marijuana marijuana with cocaine, crack and heroin culture as a felony. Yet someone can sit there smoking marijuana, sitting quietly and objectively has earned that marijuana is the least harmful chemical used for pleasure and non-violence."

"Behind all the words in the reality, the detailed detail we have to do, the most important effort is to the musical field, and this home is where we work as well as our residence. Because the Dead's house is a place of peace, no effort is now interrupted as we meet with the consumers of a heretical species."

And, various followed, much like a hallelujah press conference. In response to "How long did it take you to grow that hair?" Jerry Way said, "We've always believed that if we ever held a press conference the first reporter would ask us, 'How long does it take you to grow your hair?'"

A large bowl of whipped cream was served, and the group, who had been eating nothing, started eating all the remnants except the soup. An croissants and French toast with coffee followed. The coffee was finished, coffee and cake were served out the geriatrics joined us.

Before the group left, Jerry Way said,




