1965 Drug Abuse Control Amendments

- -Control over manufacturing and distribution of "dangerous drugs"
- -"Dangerous" meant barbiturates, amphetamines, hallucinogens but it didn't name the drugs so enforcement was difficult
- -Defined "narcotics" as heroin, morphine and marijuana





Timothy Leary

Congressional Hearing - 1966

Kennedy: You said you do not know about the quality. What is it about the quality that you are frightened about?

Leary: We do not want amateur or blackmarket sale or distribution of LSD.

Kennedy: Why not?

Leary: Or the barbiturates or liquor.
When you buy a bottle of liquor –

Kennedy: This is not responsive. As to LSD, why do you not want it?

Leary: On possession?

Kennedy: Why do you not want the indiscriminate manufacture and distribution? Why not? Is it because it is dangerous?

Leary: Because you do not know what you are getting.

Kennedy: Is it because it is dangerous? Are you interested only in the consumer and whether, like truth in packaging, whether there are too many strawberries or not enough strawberries in the pie, or is it something more dangerous than that, Dr. Leary?

Leary: No sir: I think LSD is much less dangerous than the amphetamines and barbiturates.

Kennedy: I am not asking that. The reason, as I would gather it, is this is a dangerous drug: is that right?

Leary: No sir: LSD is not a dangerous drug.

- -First commissioner of the Federal Bureau of Narcotics – 1932-1962
- -Marijuana Tax Act 1937
- -1937-1970 Marijuana was classified as a narcotic and fell under the same restrictions




The Narcotics Farms

- prison disguised as treatment 1929 1967
- --Heroin addicts and marijuana users

Lexington

1922 – Jones-Miller Act – made addicts criminals
1929 – 1/3 of all U.S. prisoners were incarcerated for drug offenses

1970 Comprehensive Drug Abuse Prevention & Control Act

- 1) Treatment provided funds for drug abuse treatment & rehabilitation (in fact every community mental health center and public health center got a drug rehabilitation officer).
- 2) HEW was given the task of setting up treatment guidelines and education programs
- many of you were probably exposed to these public awareness programs in school

NIDA - was the scientific and education organization

DEA – Legal arm

FDA – continue to regulate pharmaceutical industry

- 3) Commission on marijuana and drug abuse the act paid more attention to marijuana than other drugs.
- ---One of the stated reasons for the commission was to reduce marijuana use but in 1973 after studying the problem the commission recommended decriminalization of "possession-for-use". So that did not go over very well at the time.
- 4) Established penalties for simple possession vs. distribution
- 5) Established 5 drug schedules and the penalties associated with each drug.

Drug Schedules

Summary of the 1970 Law

- -It's not perfect
- -Drugs ranked by medical value not some moral or ethical scheme
- -Treatment and education played a major part
- -Set penalties that were consistent with perceived abuse potential

"It's time we recognize that there are gaps in our health-care system that allow too many to go without care — and invest in treatment. It's time we recognize that our state and federal prisons, where 65 percent of inmates meet medical criteria for substance use disorders, are no substitute for proper treatment — and reform our criminal justice system."
