This program is a high quality transition experience to post-secondary education for high school students with disabilities.



Transitioning from high school to either college or the workforce is an anxiety inducing time for the life of any student, especially one with disabilities. *Movin' On* is designed to help alleviate this anxiety by providing a mentoring relationship between high school students with disabilities and current MSUB students who also have a disability. Mentoring is done through technology (*WebEx* and *Facebook*) and face-to-face opportunities between the students and college mentors. The mentoring culminates with an optional four-day on-campus experience at MSUB during the summer of 2019 at no cost to the student, their family, or the school. All expenses are paid by the program.
