

Montana State University Billings Recreational Activities Membership, Locker & Towel Service Policies

Membership Terms

- Recreation Activities memberships can be purchased at the Rec. Desk in the lower floor of Physical Education Building (PE).
- Members must commit to the end of a semester. No MONTH-to-MONTH memberships!
- Student and student family membership are sold by the semester.
- All other memberships cannot extend beyond Summer 2018 (August 31, 2018).
- Memberships are valid for scheduled recreation center hours only.
- The individual is responsible for his/her conduct and following established gym safety rules and center policies.

Locker Rental Terms

- Lockers are only available to current Recreation Activities members.
- The lock and locker is the property of MSU Billings.
- Lockers that are not renewed before clean out date will be cleaned out and contents will be inventoried and bagged. Bagged locker contents will be stored for 90 days.
- The fee for a lost lock, lost combination, or damaged lock is \$10.00.

Towel Service

- Towel service is only available to current Recreation Activities members.
- To receive a new towel, old towel must be returned to Rec. Desk.
- Towel service is for the individual.
- Service cannot be shared by a group of individuals.

Child Policy: Children under the age of 5 do not need to purchase a membership, but must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Children between 5 and 15 years of age can purchase a membership, but must be accompanied by an adult. Individuals 16 and older can purchase membership and visit center without another adult.

Recreation Center and Aquatics Membership Groups

MSU Billings Students: – All students enrolled at MSU Billings who have paid the Recreation Activities Fee can use Recreation Center and participate in Recreation Activities programs. All students taking classes on campus and all MSUB On-Line only students residing in the 5 county area pay the full fee at the 1 credit level. MSUB On-Line only students living outside the 5 county area who are not charged the Rec Activities Fee can purchase a Recreation Activities membership for the standard MSUB student rate.

MSU Nursing Students—Students who are registered for the MSU Nursing program must pay the Recreation Activities fee at the Recreation Desk in lower level of Physical Education building. Student fees for nursing student have been waived and must be manually paid in order to use service.

Students – Other MUS colleges and universities: Any currently enrolled student at a MUS college/university will be allowed access as long as they have paid a Recreation Fee at their college/university. Any currently enrolled student at a MUS college/university that has not paid a Recreation Fee at their college/university can purchase a facility pass for the standard MSUB student rate.

Employees MSU Billings: Any employee of MSU Billings or MSU Billings foundation can purchase a Recreation Activities membership.

Faculty/Staff – Other MUS colleges and universities: Any Faculty/Staff working on the MSU Billings campus but employed by another MUS college/university can pay the MSUB PE Building User Fee at the MSUB employee rate.

Families of Students/Faculty/Staff: Families of Students/Faculty/Staff that have paid the MSUB Rec Activities Fee or MSUB PE Building User Fee can purchase a pass for their immediate family. Rates will depend on family unit type and number of family members.

MSU Billings Alumni: Any graduate of MSU Billings can purchase a Recreation Activities Alumni Membership. Alumni status will be confirmed with the MSU Billings Alumni Association. MSUB Alumni Memberships are for individual alumni. Alumni family members are not eligible to purchase a Recreation Activities membership.

Aquatic Center Memberships: Individual and family memberships can be purchased for the MSUB Aquatics Center. Aquatic Center memberships grant access to the swimming pool facilities only. Access to all other areas of MSUB Recreation Center is prohibited.
