There was not a quorum, so the Committee discussed the conversion of the COT to a Community College, and other General Education/COT issues.

It was noted that the survey of students conducted last year mainly missed all of the COT students because most of the questions did not apply to them.

It was also noted that if the COT becomes a community college that offers AA's and AS's for transfer to another institution, the curriculum will be largely general education courses. Therefore, these courses must have transferability. Re-crafting and creating new integrated courses would not only be useful, but vital to the AA and AS curriculum.

It was cited that unlike the senior campus, at the COT General Education is a separately funded entity.
