A. Debrief – Chairs Meeting

It was suggested that the Committee next meet with the Arts & Sciences Curriculum Council to discuss the structure of the program and possible submission guidelines. It was noted that the other college curriculum committees should also be notified, and meetings scheduled so no one feels blindsided. It was noted that the Arts & Sciences Curriculum Council meets this Friday.

It was also noted that some people mistakenly thought the courses to fit into Gen Ed were already selected. It has to be clear that process is still in the future.

The Committee then further edited the main General Education/Academic Foundations document.

It was noted that the new condensed categories need to be defined. It was decided they should be discussed at the next meeting.

The Committee also thanked Mark Hardt for his excellent presentation and control under stress at the Chairs meeting last week.
