Dan Gretch called the meeting to order at 3:46 p.m. in the Bridger room of the SUB.

The minutes of October 3 were accepted as presented.

I. Discussion/Action Items

A. Revise Academic Foundations Document to Include BOR Oral Communication Requirement

B. Revise Matrix to Include BOR Oral Communication Requirement

It was noted that oral communication needs to be added in just a few places in the Academic Foundations Document, but more will be needed for the matrix. It was agreed that the Information Literacy category name would not change; a requirement will simply be added for oral communication.

Three new outcomes were added to the matrix under I. Skills Development & Application:

- 4. Develop effective oral communication skills.
 - a. Demonstrate ability to verbally present information using a variety of techniques.
 - b. Demonstrate ability to understand and interpret oral information.
 - c. Demonstrate the ability to undertake and accomplish original work in oral form.

- Motion by Barb Pedula, seconded by James Ellis to approve on first reading the changes to the Academic Foundations Document and the Matrix to include an oral communications requirement.
- Motion carried.

C. Compose Notification to Information Literacy Courses: Need to revise and resubmit to meet BOR Oral Communication requirement

As you develop your Academic Foundations assessment tool, please plan to incorporate measures of the three new outcomes added to the matrix.

E. Pilot Assessment

It was noted that last week Dean Khaleel suggested the following way to assess courses in a category: "In one category, assess three types of courses: (1) a course that is offered on the east campus and at the COT, (2) a course that is offered in-class and online, and (3) two other courses with different rubrics from the first two." (from the minutes of 10/3/06) It was noted that in many categories, this will not be possible as there are only one or two rubrics.

It was noted that we will need to pick some courses to be assessed this spring very soon, so those departments will be prepared to assess.
