

IME-BECAS MONTANA STATE UNIVERSITY BILLINGS SCHOLARSHIP FOR MEXICAN OR MEXICAN-ORIGIN STUDENTS

The Office of International Studies has been awarded \$3,000.00 from the Institute of Mexicans Abroad (IME) and the Consulate General of Mexico in Denver to create a new scholarship for students from Mexico or Mexican-origin students in Central and Eastern Montana and the United States. The MSUB Foundation has agreed to match this award so as to make a greater impact among students who trace their heritage to Mexico.

The IME-BECAS Montana State University Billings Scholarship has begun to accept applications. To apply, students must be first admitted to MSU Billings and then apply for scholarships on the Scholarships webpage at msubillings.edu/scholarships

To be eligible, students must be admitted to MSU Billings and be able to prove their Mexican origin. All students will be asked to submit a short essay (500 words) in which they will describe both their educational goals at MSU Billings and provide details of their Mexican origin.

The scholarships (for the entire academic year, but awarded for each semester) are in the following amounts: City College \$500.00 per year; Undergraduate BA/BS \$750.00 per year; Graduate MA/MS \$1,000.00 per year. The scholarships will be awarded on a rolling basis, beginning on June 1, 2018 and continuing until the funds are exhausted.
